

"A Message from Fr. Anthony Wroblewski

There is an old English Christmas Carol called "In the Bleak Mid-Winter" that rarely is sung in Church here in the United States, but has a haunting melody, and absolutely beautiful words. The following are the last two verses of the song:

Angels and Archangels, may have gathered there, Cherubim and seraphim, thronged the air; But only His Mother, in her maiden bliss Worshipped the Beloved, with a kiss.

What can I give Him, poor as I am? If I were a Shepherd, I would bring a lamb; If I were a Wise Man, I would do my part, Yet what I can I give Him, give my heart.

Someone asked a few of us a question just before Christmas: What is your favorite hymn. The answer of one of them was "The Little Drummer Boy." At first I thought it a bit odd. But then I realized that the greatest gift humanity ever received was the gift of God's Son. And in gratitude for that gift, we are to give something back to God: ourselves. That's why I love the last line in this hymn: when we give our heart back to Christ, He will take it and use it to spread His love everywhere in this world.

I am always aware of the many people who come back to us at Church, whether to visit family and friends, or are simply returning back to the Faith. Know that we are glad you are here! We always want to make this place a welcoming, joyful place where Christ's love, compassion and mercy are known. Even in the midst of a pandemic, we rejoice, because our God came to save us!

And for those of you visiting our parish community, know we are glad you are here with us.
