

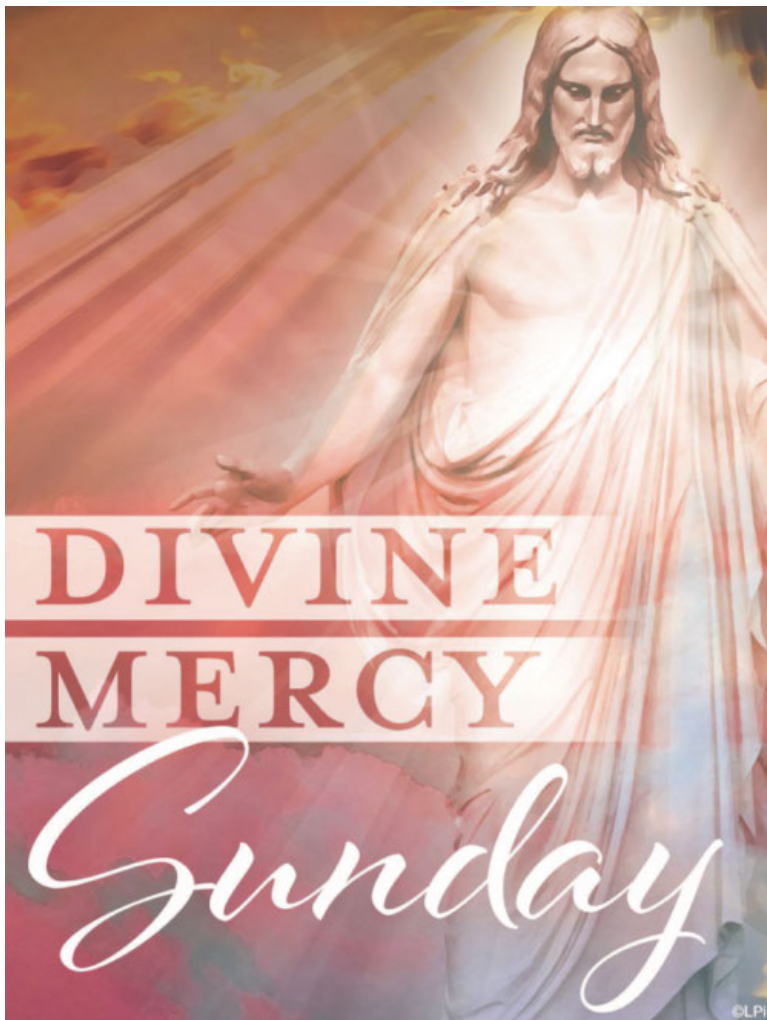

Faith Formation: Happy Divine Mercy Sunday. In today's Gospel we hear the powerful retelling of Jesus appearing to his Disciples with the gift of peace and the gift of the Holy Spirit. He commissions his Disciples to go and continue the work that he had begun, to show mercy, and forgiveness of sins to those in need.

Jesus tells us that as his followers, we too must show mercy to others just as our heavenly Father shows mercy to us. According to Fr. Chris Alar from Ascension Press, “Works of mercy and being merciful are not optional, we need them to get into the Kingdom of God.” Fr. Chris has a great short video series on Ascension Press that talks about the message that God has been delivering to us from the beginning of human history. He tells us that if we want to join God in Heaven, we must live out the ABCs of God's Mercy. First, we must **A**sk for God's Mercy, second, we must **B**e merciful to each other and third, we need to **C**ompletely trust in the mercy of God. This may not always be an easy task for us, but it is a necessary one.

The same can be said for our children, as our children grow in their awareness that they are called to be witnesses to Christ, it is our job as parent's and family members to help foster this growth. Each of us has received the gift of the Holy Spirit as well as the forgiveness of sins, through our Baptism. Our Baptism, then, invites us to share in the peace that Christ gave to his disciples and commissions us to share that with others. As our children grow in this awareness, it is up to us to help them put their trust in the Lord as they live out their faith daily.

As St. Faustina reminds us, “Jesus I Trust In You,” for when we trust in him, we completely entrust ourselves to him and to Jesus the Divine Mercy. Blessed are we, for we have not seen and yet have believed.
