

Faith Formation: Today's Gospel speaks powerfully about the familiarity and intimacy between Jesus and his disciples, expressed as recognizing and knowing another's voice.

We have to know a person pretty well to be able to recognize their voice without seeing them. Growing up, we come to know our family members very well and not only recognize their voices, but to also read the tone of their voices and know something about how they are feeling. Jesus knows us as well as our family and our best friends, Jesus knows everything about us.

In our relationship with Jesus, we know Jesus' voice and are called to follow Him. We are the sheep he is talking about in today's Gospel. Just as a shepherd loves and protects his sheep, so too does Jesus. He is our shepherd, the one who guides us, protects us and loves us.

Our relationship with Jesus doesn't just bring us closer to the Father, it puts us directly into contact with God the Father, removing all distance between us. Jesus identifies so closely with the Father that he tells us that they are one—not just close, but actually one. Our relationship with Jesus is an invitation to share in the life of the Father. To know Jesus is to know the Father.

Throughout our life, we hope and pray that we will grow ever closer to God as we learn to follow Jesus more fully. Jesus shows how to be closer to God and gives us eternal life in heaven, all we have to do is follow.
