

"A Message from Fr. Anthony Wroblewski

It's that time of the year once again. When you are reading this article, I will be preparing to make my yearly retreat. Last year, Fr. Seth and I made our retreat at a Carmelite retreat house in California. The sisters that run the place, when priests are on retreat, pray constantly for those priests. I have no doubt that's why the retreats we have made there have always been so powerful. We have already reserved our rooms for a retreat there in two years.

Every two years the Diocese sponsors a preached retreat for the priests at Christ the King Retreat Center in Buffalo, MN. Due to Covid however, we didn't have a preached retreat two years ago. So this will be the first time we gather as a fraternity of priests to pray together and hear some fine talks since 2019. I am very much looking forward to it.

Every priest is required by Church Law to make an annual retreat. It is that important that the Church demands that of its clergy. I have heard it said, and can testify to the truth of it from my own experience, that when a person makes a retreat, it will take at least two or even three days for a person's mind to calm down enough so that good prayer and mediation actually begins taking place. We need to calm our minds if we are to be attentive enough to hear the Lords voice within the depth of our souls. We live in a noisy, fast paced world. So we need times when we so focus our minds and bodies in prayer that finally we are attentive enough to hear the voice of God. I do ask you to pray for me this week, as I will undoubtedly be praying for you, my dear parishioners.

Finally, I thought this may be a good time to remind you that we will once again be having a mission this year! It is scheduled to take place at the end of March with a theme of healing. The person I have asked to give the mission is unfortunately suffering from Leukemia. She still hopes to be able to do the talks. Her name is Connie Bruesh, and I ask you to pray for her. She says this bout with cancer will give her more of a story to tell you! So pray she can heal and do God's will.

Perhaps you might now start thinking about making that a kind of retreat for yourself. Maybe take a day or two off of work. Decide you will spend some significant time in prayer that week, either here at the Cathedral or at home. Take time to be renewed and rejuvenated in your Catholic Faith. May God Bless you, and may we hold each other in prayer.

Following the teaching of the Beatitudes in last week's Gospel, Jesus uses the familiar metaphors of salt and light to describe the life of discipleship in today's Gospel. Jesus' call to be salt for the earth and light for the world powerfully states our mission as a Church and as Christians.

Today we hear Jesus emphasize the importance of our actions. Just as the phrase "actions speak louder than words," states, we are called to be the salt of the earth and light of the world not only through our words, but also our actions.

When we as Christians engage in the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy such as feeding the hungry, sheltering the homeless, clothing the naked, comforting those who mourn, and praying for the living and the dead, we show that we act as the light of the world and the salt of the earth as Jesus taught us.

What does it mean to your family to say that Christians are to be the light of the world? How might you and your family act in a way that is a light for others, a light that is worthy to put on a lamp stand? I invite you to take a closer look at your parish bulletin this week and choose one thing that you and your family can do to show that you are the light of the world.

For when we do these things with the community of faith, the Church, we are indeed acting as disciples of Jesus.
