**Volunteer opportunity:**

Our volunteers keep good food from going to waste by rescuing it from food donors and delivering it to area agencies that serve people who are food insecure. **In 2019 our volunteers rescued 2.5 million pounds of food, serving 19,000 neighbors in need!** Volunteers interact with food donor organizations, box up and load food donations into a Table to Table van, and transport and unload the food at recipient organizations such as community pantries, shelters, preschools, etc. Route shifts typically take place between 8am-Noon Monday-Friday and last about 2-3 hours. Number of shifts each week depends on the need and the volunteer's availability. If you are feeling well and have a bit of time on your hands (even just a few hours during the week) and would like to volunteer, **please email [volunteer@table2table.org](mailto:volunteer@table2table.org) or call 319-337-3400 to chat about volunteer opportunities.** More information is available at our website: <https://table2table.org/volunteers/>. Masks are required and we have implemented additional safety precautions in accordance with CDC guidelines.



**Things to know:**

- Must have a valid driver's license and access to a vehicle
- Volunteers typically lift 35-40 lb. boxes of food
- Must wear a mask and follow social distancing guidelines
- Must be willing to volunteer a minimum of 30 total hours

**If any of the following is true for you, we will require you to wait at least 14 days before volunteering.**

**Since the volunteer orientation occurs remotely, you may reach out and begin the process at any time. Circumstances and waiting periods will be further discussed during the orientation process:**

- \* You, or someone you live with, has tested positive for COVID-19.
- \* You, or someone you live with, is currently awaiting the results of a COVID-19 test.
