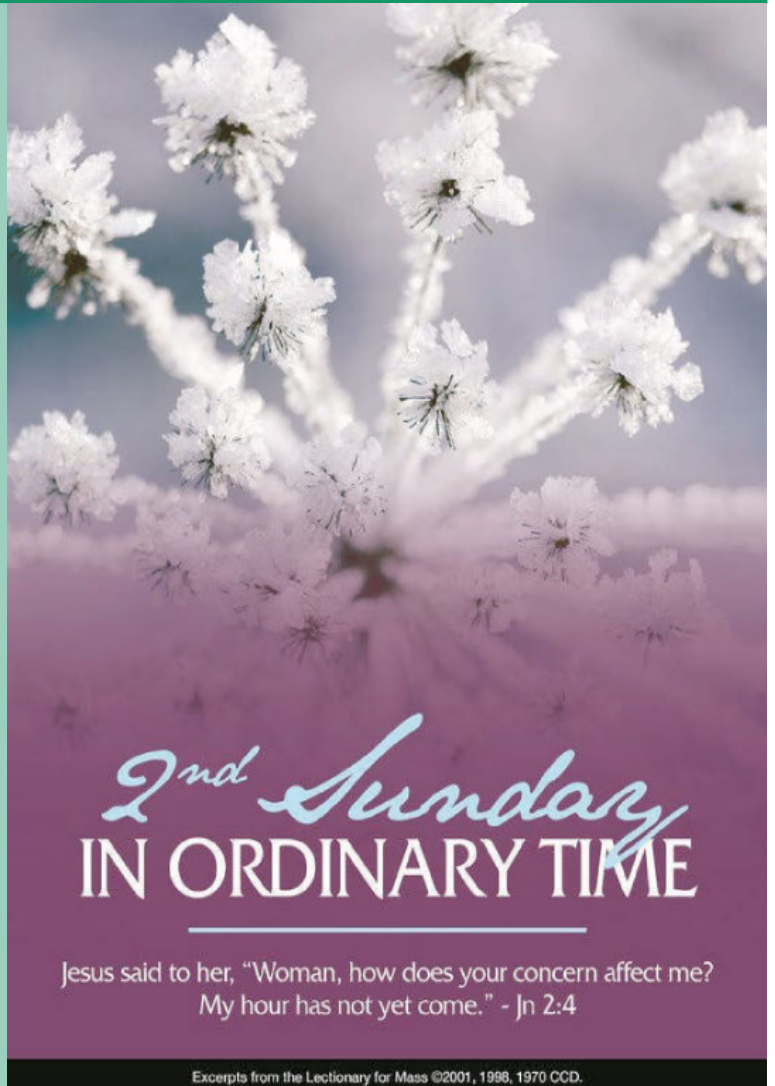

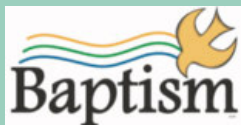

**K-8 RE Inclement Weather Policy**

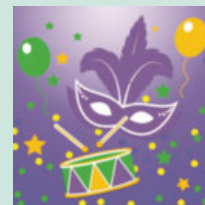
