

Pastor's Letter

THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

 While considering the Mystery of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, body and soul. into heaven, we are invited to ask for the grace of a greater devotion and recourse to our Blessed Mother. The Mystery itself elicits that request. It is the mystery of the love of Jesus Christ, the divine, incarnate Word, for His Mother and of His Mother for her divine Son. This is a unique relationship, a unique bond like none other. From the first moment of her Immaculate Conception Mary was filled with God's love and grace; she never ceased to give an unreserved return of love to God throughout her earthly life. Jesus has taught us that "where your treasure is, there your heart will also be" (St. - Matt 6:21). There was never another treasure in Mary's heart than her Jesus, and there was never a heart like that of Mary. The Immaculate Heart of Mary followed her treasure, Jesus, into heaven. Jesus and-Mary, Mother and Son were, thus, never really separated at His ascension. As the Mother's heart could not be separated from her Son, neither could the love of the divine Son not draw that heart unto Himself.

When Pope Pius XII solemnly proclaimed and defined in 1950 the bodily Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary into heaven as a dogma of the Catholic Church, he affirmed that "Scripture portrays the loving Mother of God, almost before our very eyes, as most intimately united with her divine Son and always sharing in His destiny."-... "Therefore, just as the glorious resurrection of Christ was an essential part of (His) victory (over sin and death) and its final trophy, so the struggle shared by the blessed Virgin and her Son was to end in the glorification of her virginal body." ... "Hence, the august Mother of God, mysteriously united from all eternity with Jesus Christ in one and the same decree of predestination, immaculate in her conception, a virgin inviolate in her divine motherhood, the wholehearted companion of the divine Redeemer who won complete victory over sin and its consequences, gained at last the supreme crown of her privileges - to be preserved immune from the corruption of the tomb, and, like her Son, when death had been conquered, to be carried up body and soul to the exalted glory of heaven, there to shine as Queen at the right hand of her Son, the immortal King of the ages" (cf.-DS 3900: 3901: 3902).

In its chapter on the Blessed Virgin Mary in the life of the Church, the Second Vatican Council's Dogmatic Constitution on the Church, "Lumen Gentium", teaches us that, "In the most holy Virgin the Church has already reached that perfection whereby she exists without spot or wrinkle" (#65), and "In the bodily and spiritual glory which she possesses in heaven, the Mother of Jesus continues in this present world as the image and first flowering of the Church as it is to be perfected in the world to come" (#68).

SCRIPTURE REFLECTIONS FOR NEXT SUNDAY, 21ST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME:

Joshua 24:1-2a, 15-17, 18b The message was simple and straightforward for the Israelites, as it is for us: "decide today whom you will serve."

Ephesians 5:21-32 "Subordination" is not the same as "subservience." For the Christian, St. Paul teaches us that we are all called to serve on another, motivated solely "out of reverence for Christ."

St. John 6:60-69 Echoing the posed in our first reading, Jesus asks us, "Do you also want to leave?" True faith is tested in the challenges we meet, and is proven worthwhile when we are able to call upon it in need.

SUPPORT FOR PROLIFE CANDIDATES

A "FREE" way to support your Favorite Pro-life Party or Candidate.

To encourage personal donations to political campaigns, the State of Minnesota will refund the first \$50 of any individual's donation (\$100 for a married couple) to any qualified candidate or qualified political party in Minnesota.

The refund is limited to once each calendar year (Jan.1-Dec. 31, 2021), and the individual donor must be an American citizen, least 18 years of age and eligible to vote.

There are 4 simple steps:

- 1). Make a contribution of any amount to a qualified political party or candidate. (but please remember only the first \$50 is eligible for a refund).
 - The party/candidate will mail you a receipt (Form EP-3, MN Political Contribution Receipt).
- 3). Complete the State Refund Application form (2021 Form PCR), if you do not receive a blank form along with your receipt, one is available online at the State's website: (https:// www.revenue.state.mn.us/political-contribution-refund)
 - 4). You are done! The Minnesota Department of Revenue will send your refund.


