# Pastor's Letter

## ALLELUIA!

There are a few remnants the Church has retained in her Liturgy that are taken from both her Jewish and her Greek roots. "Alleluia," "hosanna," and "amen" are three that remain from Christianity's Jewish prayer-roots.

Some have attempted to translate "alleluia" as "praise the Lord!" or something like that, but even the most exuberant form of that English phrase falls short. That's why the Church has kept the original Hebrew word, because nothing else even comes close to expressing the inexpressible joy that disciples of the Lord Jesus experience as they recall His resurrection from the dead: *Alleluia!*

That joy doesn't just happen; it is the fruit of having been united with Jesus in a death like His by having shared spiritually in the mystery of His saving Passion, especially during Lent and Holy Week.

There can be no Easter Sunday without first Good Friday; there can be no empty tomb without first the cross; there can be no "alleluia joy" without first the desolation of Calvary. This is the spiritual journey of Christians that culminates in a share in the victory of the Lord Jesus over sin and death. So, we who have followed Him more closely of late, let's now sing our "*Alleluia!*" not only with our voices, but, more importantly, with our lives.

In my own name, and on behalf of the entire parish staff, I offer my sincerest prayer for a deeper faith and holy joy as we together celebrate the resurrection of our Lord, Jesus Christ!

### SCRIPTURE REFLECTIONS FOR NEXT SUNDAY, 2<sup>ND</sup> SUNDAY OF EASTER, *DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY*:

**Acts 5:12-16** "Great numbers of believers in the Lord were added" to the first community of Christians because the power of the risen Lord Jesus Christ was evident among them.

**Revelation 1:9-11a, 12-13, 17-19** What motivated John to write down his vision wasn't the overpowering imagery itself, but that he had been personally touched and commissioned to do so by "the first and the last," who was dead, but who now "lives forever and ever."

**St. John 20:19-31** To "have not seen and have believed" doesn't mean there is no solid basis for our faith. The peace that the risen Lord Jesus alone brings into a life that is opened wide in faith to him vindicates that faith, and also leads the believer to "have life in his name."

Fr. Cloutier will be away April 18 -22. Therefore we will go to our one priest daily Mass schedule: Holy Childhood will have the 7:45 am Mass on Tuesday, Friday and Saturday. Maternity of Mary will have the 8:00 am Mass on Monday, Wednesday and Thursday.

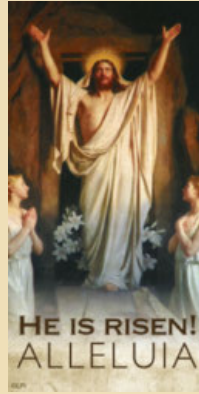

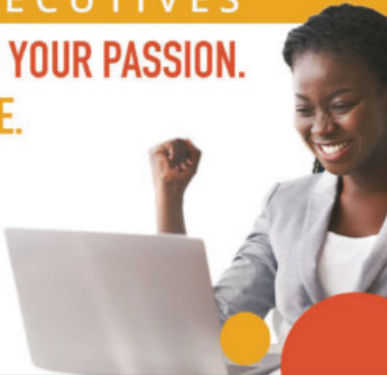
