#### Pastor's Letter THE ONES WHO MAKE IT ALL WORK

With all of the attention as of late on Fr. Fink's and my departure, I don't want to leave overlooked your attention as a Parish on those of you who make it all come together and work: the Parish Staff, the volunteers and those who quietly and generously work behind the scenes. That's what makes this Parish a viable community of faith, and attracts others to want to be here, too.

That natural abilities and talents each of you has, coupled and enlivened by the Gifts of the Holy Spirit and a willingness to share them all makes for a successful combination. #### SCRIPTURE REFLECTIONS FOR NEXT SUNDAY, 14TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME:

**Isaiah 66:10-14c:** Jerusalem is fulfilled as an image of the Church, and thus, as a promise of what God will do on behalf of all those who dwell in her through faith.

Priest-in-Solidum. What does that mean?

As taken from Wikipedia:

In 1983 the Catholic Church introduced the possibility of entrusting the pastoral care, of one or more parishes to a **team of priests** *in solidum*. This provision in the 1983 Code of Canon Law, which resembles ancient models of pastoral care in the Roman titular churches with their colleges of priests, was introduced to help resolve some of the difficulties facing many dioceses. These difficulties include shortages of priests, overpopulated urban parishes, depleted and scattered rural parishes, and decline in attendance at Mass. This model of pastoral care is viewed as a practical way of promoting pastoral co-responsibility, as well as fostering a greater sense of the presbyterium among the priests of a diocese.


