

"ETERNAL LIFE HAS ALREADY BEGUN"

First, I'd like to congratulate you, because, if you are reading these lines, it means that, unlike me, you are reading the bulletin of the Parish, and even better, my article. I hope that the Lord will reward you for this act of Charity ;-)

Since I hardly comment on the second reading in my homilies, I chose to share some of my thoughts about the passage of the letter to the Colossians that we heard this weekend. Saint Paul exhorts his brothers and sisters to welcome the grace they have received when they have been baptized. *They were buried with him in baptism, in which they were also raised with him.*

These words remain as true today as when they were first said. Let us take time today, or this week, in our personal time of prayer, to thank God for the grace we received the day we were baptized. Baptism is a sacrament we receive only once. Why? Because the grace of baptism is given every second of our life on Earth. Baptism is a perpetual begetting. Since we have been baptized, we have been Children of God, and the Father has never stopped telling us: "You are my child, whom I love".

Therefore, anytime I sin, I reject these words, but anytime I do what is good, I welcome the will of the Father, I welcome his love, and I'm already sharing his eternal Life. May God give us the grace to become who we really are: the Children of the Almighty and ever living God!


