


O Most Holy Trinity, Undivided Unity. Holy God. Mighty God. God immortal be adored!

I love this image of the Holy Trinity which beautifully portrays the Father (the "Hand" that gives life), the Son (the Lamb of God), and the Holy Spirit (in the form of a dove). The inner circles that each Person of the Trinity is portrayed in overlap each other, showing that they are each connected to one another, while the larger circle contains all three Persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, as they truly are, ONE God.

This unity in which God has chosen to reveal Himself to us through our human history should be a powerful reminder to us of what we are called to as His children, His Family. As we read in the Book of Genesis:



The action God took when He created us in His own image and likeness calls us to be an icon, a reflection, of Himself in the world. That when a man and woman come together in union, they bring life into the world through the gift of a child.

This union of man and woman and the "fruit" that they bear best reflects who God is, as His own overflowing love brings forth life into the world. For love is fruitful and we see that both in a physical and spiritual way.

Thus, the there is an utmost importance for us to pray for our families here at Presentation, but also for those throughout the whole world, that we may be nurtured in their identity as beloved sons and daughters and share the Good News to others that we may come together and truly be one as Jesus had prayed:
