

PRESENTATION OF MARY CATHOLIC CHURCH

June 19, 2022 | Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ; Father's Day

"Lo, the angel's food is given..."

Today, the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christ), is one of the few days where a liturgical poem, called a Sequence, can be used. In the past, these poems used to follow the Gospel Acclamation.

They began in the Middle Ages when the last part of the Alleluia was extended while the deacon went from the altar to the ambo to proclaim the gospel. In the ninth century, a Benedictine monk from Switzerland named Notker began to write poems in Latin that were sung in this place. By the 1500s, many feast days in the liturgical calendar had a sequence associated with them.

After the Council of Trent, the revised missal of Pius V reduced these to four holy days: Easter, Pentecost, All Soul's Day, and Corpus Christi. In our most recent revision of the Roman Missal (3rd Edition), the Sequence was moved to before the Alleluia and only those on Easter and Pentecost are required to be said or sung. So it's possible you may not have heard today's sequence very often, but it's a beautiful poem written by St. Thomas Aquinas full of meaningful reflection about the gift of the Eucharist. He also wrote several other hymns for Corpus Christi, all at the request of Pope Urban IV, including Pange lingua (Sing My Tongue The Savior's Glory), Sacris solemniis (At This Our Solemn Feast), Adoro te devote (I Devoutly Adore You), and Verbum supernum prodiens (The Word Descending From Above).

The full text of the Sequence for Corpus Christi can be found at <u>https://bible.usccb.org/bible/readings/061922.cfm</u>. I hope it will enhance your celebration of today's solemnity! Here is the shorter version of the Sequence:

"Lo! the angel's food is given To the pilgrim who has striven; see the children's bread from heaven, which on dogs may not be spent. Truth the ancient types fulfilling, Isaac bound, a victim willing, Paschal lamb, its lifeblood spilling, manna to the fathers sent. Very bread, good shepherd, tend us, Jesu, of your love befriend us, You refresh us, you defend us, Your eternal goodness send us In the land of life to see. You who all things can and know, Who on earth such food bestow, Grant us with your saints, though lowest, Where the heav'nly feast you show, Fellow heirs and guests to be. Amen. Alleluia."
