God's Name is Howard

Are you hungry? When our body tells us we are hungry, we find something to eat. As children of God we are more than just a body. We are a body and a soul and the hunger of our soul is more difficult to determine. We need to listen to the longings in our heart.

Prayer is how we feed our soul because in prayer God gives us His Divine Self in love. Prayer is simply raising our mind and heart to God. It is a look toward heaven recognizing God and His love for us in both trials and joy. We pray because God's goodness and greatness deserve it, but also for the grace, beauty, and peace that prayer brings to our soul. Our soul animates our life, and it needs to be fed by prayer.

We should pray at all times, continuously throughout the day. God lives in us, in our heart, and praying keeps us united to God's presence. Praying continuously does not need to be long or complicated. Simple prayers asking God for help, or strength, or thanking Him for blessings are all that is needed. We can use everyday things as reminders for us of God's presence. Every time we enter a building or a vehicle, we can ask for God's blessings and peace. Whenever our cell phone rings or beeps we can say a prayer, such as "Praise God". When we hear a siren or see an emergency vehicle we can say a prayer (Father Bill Baer used to encourage people to pray to St. Theresa of Lisieux when they heard a siren by praying, "Little flower in this hour show your power," and this is a powerful prayer to use in any situation).

With a little effort we can develop the habit of praying in thanksgiving, for forgiveness, for help, for strength, for wisdom, peace, and patience. Praying continuously shouldn't be a distraction, it should go along side of whatever we do. It keeps us united to God and His presence, the presence that always lives in each of us.

This weekend in the gospel reading, the disciples ask Jesus to teach them to pray and Jesus teaches them the

prayer we know as the Our Father. At the end of the day it is a great practice to slowly reflect on the Our Father prayer. This prayer, if said with reflection, will help order our life and our prayer.

A young first grade student once told his parents, "I know God's name. His name is Howard." The parents asked him how he knew God's name was Howard. The boy told them, "It is in the prayer I say every night. Our Father, who art in heaven. Howard is His name."
