

PRESENTATION OF MARY CATHOLIC CHURCH July 31, 2022 | 18th Sunday in Ordinary Time

"Create a clean heart in me, O God." -Psalm 51

We celebrate the Feast Day of Saint John Marie Vianney on August 4th, the patron saint of parish priests and co-patron with Saint Paul of our local Church, the Archdiocese of Saint Paul & Minneapolis. Last year I shared how he has been a source of inspiration for me as a priest about perseverance and keeping the end (heaven) always in mind/sight. Now there's another story I would like to share with you about this saintly priest.

The life of Saint John Vianney has been revealed as one that was spent with much time praying for his parishioners, so much so that one could say that he lived in the church building itself. Many could look at that lifestyle and criticize him about how effective he was in using his time... wouldn't it have been better if he had just gone out to serve the poor more or build more shelters/homes for those in need instead of just spending it in prayer? Possibly.

However, we know that what he did during his time in this world was definitely well spent and very much effective by the fruits of his labor and by the fact that the devil himself despised Saint John Vianney.

The fruits of his labor... Recall that when he arrived in the little town of Ars in France, though there was a church in this town, many, if not all, the people had stopped attending Mass. During this time, the French Revolution was happening and anyone part of a hierarchy was being persecuted, including the Church and her priests. Thus, a Christian country was now becoming de-Christianized because of this so called "revolution". So it would make sense that many people would stay away from the Church because of these ideologies and the fear of being persecuted themselves.

Through Saint John Vianney's prayer life, which involved much fasting and self-mortification, he bore much fruit from these spiritual and physical labors as many of the people began to return to the sacraments, notably to Mass and especially the sacrament of Reconciliation.

There was a downside to his bearing so much fruit for our Lord though, if you can call it a downside. As we know, the more we do the work that Jesus calls us to, the more the devil becomes unhappy and will persecute you for it to try and make you stop. It's been said that Saint John Vianney would be visited by the devil often at bedtime to keep him

from getting sleep and scare him away from Ars and the work he was doing. This had become so regular that there came a point in time when he no longer paid attention to it, as it was now just a normal part of his life.

If anything we can take away from his life, my dear brothers and sisters, is that when we are truly doing the work of our Lord Jesus Christ, be assured that the devil will definitely make an appearance to try and stop that work. Nothing more that this fiend wants then to keep us away from the One who loves us the most.

Saint John Vianney, pray for us, our families, our priests and our local Church that we would keep our eyes on heaven and not be led astray by the devil's attempt to keep us from Jesus and our eternal home.


