



# PRESENTATION OF MARY CATHOLIC CHURCH

August 7, 2022 | 19th Sunday in Ordinary Time

***"Blessed the people the Lord has chosen to be his own." -Psalm 33***

The power of the sacrament of baptism is a very real thing. That's why Christians from of old would have their entire households baptized in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Baptism is more than just the washing away of Original Sin and any sins we may have on our souls, but through it we are also consecrated to God as we become a part of His family. Consecrated, meaning, to be set aside for holy use. Thus in baptism when a person is baptized, does God truly live within their soul as God Himself has been invited to make His home in that person. (Note: this is a very simplified explanation about baptism.)

However, it's not only people who can be consecrated to God but also objects. Here I want to share with you an event that will be taking place next week, to which any who would like to attend, may do so.

Next Saturday, August 13th at 9:00am in the Divine Mercy Chapel (our adoration chapel), Bishop Joseph Williams will be here at our parish, Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary, to celebrate Mass for us in our chapel, and during that Mass he will consecrate the altar that had been installed there.

For those of you who have visited the Divine Mercy Chapel since it has been turned into the adoration chapel (5 years ago), you may have noticed that the surfaces of the altar and the tabernacle counter were incomplete. A makeshift countertop and altar top had been installed and covered over with cloth until the day it could be completed... which happened just last summer when the parishioner who had originally helped with the project came in and said, in so many words, that he would like to finish this project.

Thanks be to God he and a friend came together and not only completed those tops but also changed out the wood statue stand where the statue of Mary resides to match. Now this beautiful chapel's sanctuary is almost complete...

The final touch... it is now time to consecrate this completed marble altar to set it aside for only holy works... namely, to be a worthy place for the sacrifice of the Mass to occur, as well as to be the place where that same Sacrifice, Jesus in the Eucharist, will continue to be available for the faithful to come spend time with Jesus in prayer.

Space is limited in our beautiful chapel, but all are invited to take part in this celebration. We will try to accommodate as many as possible that morning for Mass. A simple reception to celebrate this wonderful occasion will follow in the Parish Center.
