

# PRESENTATION OF MARY CATHOLIC CHURCH

August 14, 2022 | 20th Sunday in Ordinary Time

### The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Tomorrow the Church celebrates the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, but because it is on a Monday this year, it is not a holy day of obligation. It still is, however, an important day that has both historical and theological meaning.

On All Saints' Day in 1950, Pope Pius XII wrote an encyclical entitled "The Most Bountiful God" that proclaimed the Assumption of Mary as a dogma of the Catholic Church, a teaching that we must hold true in faith. The Pope, however, did not come up with this on his own. Several sources from from different languages and regions from as early as the fourth century testify to the belief in the Assumption.

Tradition holds that Mary lived at two places after Pentecost, one in Jerusalem and the other in Ephesus. The latter is where St. John lived. Recall, Jesus from the cross, asked them to take care of each other. Basilicas were built over these locations and neither has her body! The emperor sought to translate the relics of Mary to the capitol in 451 AD but the bishop of Jerusalem wrote telling him that Mary died in the presence of the Apostles and when St. Thomas asked her tomb to be opened, found it empty. They concluded, the bishop said, that her body was assumed into heaven.

Whether she died first as the bishop said or went to heaven before, the Pope left open to debate saying the Assumption occurred after her earthly life was complete. Both Enoch and Elijah were assumed into heaven before death, and Mary, being the Mother of God and preserved from the effects of original sin, certainly could have been preserved from death.

Either way, the Assumption has been celebrated for hundreds of years as a solemnity. The belief was so widely

held, that, like the doctrine of the Immaculate Conception declared a hundred years earlier, there was a ground-swell of bishops asking the Pope to declare the Assumption a dogma. He polled them, and over 1190 bishops responded, nearly unanimously, that it should be declared a dogma of faith.


In his encyclical, Pius XII, just after the horrors of WWII and the holocaust, wrote that "it is our hope that belief in Mary's bodily Assumption into heaven will make our belief in our own resurrection stronger and render it more effective." May this day bring us hope in our day, that believing the the resurrection of the body, one day we will be untied with Jesus, Mary, and all the Saints.
