

Merry Christmas to you and your family from all of us at St. Mary's Catholic Church. Our parish staff wish you many blessings through our Infant King's hand in the year to come. Join us in marking this feast with gratitude to God in our hearts and goodwill to all whom He was born to save.

This year I am thinking about a sermon I read from a Protestant preacher. He imagines the shepherds after the manger, after they have adored the Christ. They sit around their little camp fire in the fields and eat their meager shepherds' rations. Everything is the same, but it is different. One of the shepherds drops his bread on the ground, into some of the muck from the sheep- an occupational hazard. He smiles and laughs: "It is good brothers! It is all good!"

As Christians, our Christmas must be more than warm feelings and glad tidings. It must be a transformation of how we see the world. A shepherd losing some of his meal to the muck? No longer a disaster but a part of life and not removed from God's goodness. It is good.

The person of the Holy Trinity, the Eternal Son, has become an earthly son, born of the Virgin Mary by the power of the Holy Spirit so that we might become daughters and sons of the Eternal Father. Everything is different because of this one day. The shepherds adoring Him in the manger couldn't confess such nuanced theology but with open hearts they knew that this world was different.

May this year's celebration of Christmas cause you to see the world as ever more enchanted by the "invasion" of our King who has come, who is still hear in Sacrament, and who will come in glory.
