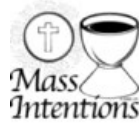

This weekend marks the first “ordinary” weekend we have had in some time. Ordinary time is called just that because it does not have any particular moment in the life of Christ that is being celebrated or prepared for. So now that the holidays have come and gone, and the new year is well on its way... what do we do now? If you are a daily Mass goer, you may have heard me mention before that Ordinary time is one of my favorite times of the year. That is because it is in ordinary time, rather, the ordinary moments of our life, that heroic sanctity is made. At times we long for the “mountain top” moments of our faith, where our Lord seems downright tangible, but those moments are not a regular part of our spiritual life, and to count on them would do us a disservice. Rather it is in the ordinary, everyday, boots on the ground drudgery of everyday life and the choices we make to cooperate with our Lord, that make all of the difference. Right now, our Lord is on the throne, and He loves you. He is pouring out His grace upon you and giving you everything that you need to be faithful to Him. He desires that we exercise our gift of faith and walk trusting that He does answer our prayers. What would it look like for you to walk with living faith? How might your day be scheduled if it revolved around your relationship with our Lord? What are the things that you have been putting off either because of laziness, apathy, or downright stubbornness with our Lord? Now is the time. The yeses that you make right now during the everyday, ordinariness of life is what keeps the ship moving in the right direction. So let us take these weeks of Ordinary Time, to cultivate, nourish, and share our living faith.
