

This past Friday, January 21 was the 49th annual March for Life in Washington D.C. "The March for Life is an inspiring, peaceful, vibrant, and joy-filled rally of women, men, young people, and children from all across the country. Every year, tens of thousands of pro-lifers converge on the National Mall and march on Capitol Hill on the anniversary of the Supreme Court's 1973 Roe v. Wade ruling which legalized abortion in all 50 states. It's the largest annual human rights demonstration in the world. But this is not just a protest... TOGETHER, WE GATHER TO CELEBRATE LIFE. We celebrate each and every life, from the moment of conception. We envision a world where every life is celebrated, valued, and protected."

The march is not long-distance, maybe only a mile or so but it takes several hours to walk the distance with that many people.

What I love about the March for Life is getting to meet people I was marching beside and talking about where we are from and what brought us to the march. Also, the energy that it brings, many people are praying while many others are chatting and singing as they march. The March is very much a family event. I have seen many families there with their children carrying their kids on their backs or pushing them in strollers. The majority of people that come to this event are young people which may surprise some people. It serves as a reminder that we are a pro-life generation!
