From Father Michael Garry

THE WORD "EPIPHANY" MEANS "REVELATION." —You're thinking, "I know that, we covered that two weeks ago on the feast of Epiphany" as you check the bulletin to see if you have the right date. You are reading the correct bulletin. It's true, the feast of Epiphany was two weeks ago, but two weeks later we are still in the afterglow of that feast. Last weekend we celebrated the Baptism of the Lord, and now this weekend we




celebrate the Wedding Feast at Cana. Historically, all three of these mysteries of Christ's life have been associated with each other under the rubric of "epiphany" or the revelation of the identity and mission of Christ.

In less than 180 years after the resurrection of Christ, there was already a yearly festival on January 6th to commemorate His Baptism at the Jordan River. Within the first 500 years of Christianity the Church had developed a chain of feasts celebrating His birth, the visit of the Magi, His Baptism in the Jordan, and His first miracle at the wedding in Cana. At one time or another all three of these festivals were called Epiphany. There was even a time when Epiphany was its own liturgical season, like Advent or Christmas! Why have these three feasts always been associated with Epiphany? What is the connection between them?

One thing that each of these events have in common is that they are the first event to reveal or manifest Christ's glory in the Gospels of Matthew, Mark, and John, respectively. In chapter 2 of Matthew's Gospel the glory of Christ is revealed to the Magi. Marks's Gospel opens in chapter 1 with the Baptism of the Lord and the voice from the heavens affirming His divine sonship. In chapter 2 of John's Gospel Christ performs His first miracle at the Wedding Feast at Cana, creating a ridiculous amount of wine out of water—six stone jars together holding over 120 gallons! We read in our Gospel this weekend, "Jesus did this as the beginning of His signs at Cana in Galilee and so revealed His glory, and His disciples began to believe in Him" (In 2:11).

Every aspect of Christ's life, down to the minutest detail, is revelatory. Each mystery is like a light that illumines its surroundings, and when we place any of these mysteries side by side we gain new insights into each. The truth is symphonic and beautiful that way. We would do well not to forget the history and liturgical tradition of our Church. The content of our faith is like an endless gallery at a museum that can never be fully appreciated or exhausted. Paying attention to how Catholics have worshiped our God throughout the centuries can deeply enrich our understanding of the Christian faith today.
