St. Thomas Aquinas | January 28

One of the most famous members of the Dominican Order, St. Thomas Aquinas (1225 – 1274) is well-known by many for his theological work, "The Summa Theologiae." Born in Italy, his mother wanted him to become a Benedictine and had high hopes that he would eventually become abbot of Monte Cassino, where he spent much of his youth. To change his vocation, she had him kidnapped by his brothers on his way to Paris at the age of 19. He spent two years in their captivity. Despite this, nothing could shake him from his vocation to become a Dominican priest and he was eventually released. Once free, he went to Paris and then to Cologne, where he finished his studies with Albert the Great. The patron saint of teachers, theologians and students, St. Thomas Aquinas died in 1274. His life and the impact he had on the whole Church, however, remains alive today. -Excerpt from ©LPi


Everyone knows that we hear the Scriptures proclaimed at Mass. But how are the readings selected? Why are they selected? Is there an order to them? Since we hear the opening lines of St. Luke's Gospel in our readings this week, I thought we would take a closer look at the lectionary in general. The lectionary is a book that contains the readings for Mass. It contains almost all of the Bible, organized according to the liturgical season, feast day, or theme (like Baptism, Marriage, etc).

The lectionary is arranged in two cycles, one for Sundays and one for weekdays. The Sunday cycle is divided into three years, A, B, and C. Back in 2020 we were in Year A, in 2021 we were in Year B, and now in 2022 we are in Year C. Generally speaking, Year A goes through the Gospel of Matthew. Year B goes through the Gospel of Mark, but since Mark is the shortest Gospel Year B also includes a few weeks of Chapter 6 of John's Gospel, the Bread of Life Discourse, where Jesus speaks about the Eucharist. In Year C we read through the Gospel of Luke. So beginning this week we will be working slowly through each chapter of Luke's Gospel. Since there are only three years and four Gospels, John's Gospel is read every year during the Easter season.

The Sunday lectionary always has three readings. The first is usually from the Old Testament and is somehow connected with the Gospel reading (in your preparation for Mass you might try to discern the common theme between the first reading and the Gospel). The second reading is usually from one of the letters of the New Testament. These letters are read semicontinuously. Each Sunday we pick up close to where we left off the Sunday before, though some passages are never read.

The weekday schedule is divided into two years, Year I and Year II. Year I is read in odd-numbered years (2021, 2023, etc) and Year II is used in even-numbered years (2020, 2022, etc). There are only two readings for weekday Mass. The Gospels are the same in both years I and II. During the year the Gospels are read semi-continuously, beginning with Mark, then moving on to Matthew and Luke. The Gospel of John is read during the Easter season. For Advent, Christmas, and Lent, readings are appropriate to the season. The first reading on weekdays may be taken from the Old or the New Testament. Typically a single book is read semi-continuously (skipping over some passages) until it is finished and a new book is started.

I'm not sure if anyone but me finds this stuff interesting, but I think it's helpful knowing where we are in the lectionary and where we're going. It sounds a lot more complicated that it is, we basically just open the lectionary and follow along. They also make lectionaries for personal use called missals. Personal missals, such as the Magnificat, are extremely convenient and help us get more out of the readings at Mass.
