From Father Michael Garry

A FEW WEEKS AGO I took two of our high school boys down to my alma mater, St. Thomas University. We went to a "come and see" weekend at St. John Vianney College Seminary. It was especially edifying for me to return to the seminary where my vocation had been cultivated. Not much has changed since I joined 17 years ago. It was satisfying to see some of the house traditions that began in my time still in practice. For example, the seminarians



still lead a Marian procession through the upper quad while singing the same Marian hymns on the same song sheets. Every Tuesday night, instead of eating dinner at the campus cafeteria where the seminarians normally eat, they still eat together at the seminary and have in-house entertainment provided by the seminarians themselves (usually *very* funny!). When I was in seminary we started a spring whiffle ball tournament. They still have that tournament, but now they have nicer equipment, a loud speaker system for announcers, and play walk up songs for batters. St. John Vianney College Seminary is still the same joyful place young men go to find their vocation in Christ. Praise God.

I was also happy to have made it back on this particular weekend because it was the last weekend Masses were being offered in the chapel. On display were plans for a new (much needed) chapel, along with some new rooms and offices Construction of a new chapel required the demolition of the old one in which I had sent so many prayers up to heaven. I was happy to celebrate Mass in it as a priest one last time.

Something that struck my eye in the rendering of the new chapel was a Latin inscription on the roof beam above the altar: *TU ES FILIUS MEUS DILECTUS IN TE COMPLACUI—"You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased"* (Mk 1:11). God the Father speaks these words to Christ at His Baptism and later at His Transfiguration, which we hear a version of in our Gospel this weekend. Both of these scenes will be painted inside the sanctuary of the new chapel. This utterance from the Father is a foundational concept in the spiritual formation of any Christian, but especially for seminarians. You are the Father's beloved son in Jesus Christ! Like Christ, you have a mission; you were made for a purpose! Your vocation is one of heroism: to die to yourself and to the world. Again, all Christians share this same basic vocation and call in Christ, but it is especially important for seminarians to own and internalize this truth.

Upon seeing these words again, especially in the context of the seminary in which I once lived and prayed, these words seeped more deeply into my soul than they had for many years. It was very consoling to hear the Father speak to me again so personally. My prayer this weekend is that every Baptized Christian, no matter what their state or condition in life, will hear with Christ, the Father speak to them in the depths of their soul, "You are my beloved son/daughter; with you I am well pleased."
