



The Brainerd Catholic parishes are working on a new collective parish directory. I love parish directories. Especially given my position, I use them all the time! Whenever a priest moves to a new assignment (as we experience every couple years with associate priests at St. Francis) it's super helpful to have a directory to look through in order to recognize faces in the community. In the past I've kept a parish directory by my recliner at



home and paged through every now and then just to refresh names and faces. I find it helpful in remembering which kids belong to which parents and vice versa. As many of you know, it's almost a daily occurrence that I ask someone, "Have we met before?" and they respond "Yes..." and then comes the apology. As a priest, I find parish directories extremely helpful in getting to know the people of my parish. As helpful as parish directories are for priests, they're perhaps even more helpful for parishioners themselves. Getting to know a Catholic community of our size takes intention. We have to be intentional about getting to know people and letting them get to know us. This begins by taking part in a communal project like a parish directory. If someone complains about not knowing anyone or feeling like just a number among a sea of people, the first question might be, "Did you participate in the parish directory and let everyone else know that you are here?" It's also fun to look at directories from years gone by. They serve as a kind of timestamp for a parish, showing how the community has changed and grown through the years. In an effort to do everything we can to promote participation in this communal project, we're providing this incentive: if you sign up and get your picture taken, you will receive a FREE 8x10 photo and a FREE printed **directory.** You will also have the opportunity to order more photos at a reasonable cost. You can get your photo taken at any location, you do not need to have it taken at your specific parish. We also believe that the homebound are an important part of our Catholic community, so if you or someone you know is homebound, let us know and our volunteer photographer will come to you! Enter the code for you parish with the password "photos": Thank you all for being a part of the Brainerd Catholic Community! I hope this endeavor will help us all get to know each other better.
