

OUR CHILDREN. OUR FAITH. OUR FUTURE.

From Father Michael Garry

In our first reading this weekend, Paul and Barnabas continue their work of proclaiming the good news of the Gospel to a fledging Church. Notice that their message includes the line, "It is necessary for us to undergo many hardships to enter the kingdom of God." I appreciate the fact Paul and Barnabas are utterly honest in informing the people—at the outset—of the sacrifices required to follow Jesus.



As the Church today continues to bleed members at a staggering rate (at least in the western world), I can understand why people might be slow to advertise the difficult parts of following the fullness of the Gospel. No doubt Paul and Barnabas could think of 'reasons' for downplaying the difficult parts of the Gospel in their culture too. But, like Paul and Barnabas, we must resist that temptation and boldly proclaim, with love, the Gospel in its integrity. There are many reasons I've never liked the evangelistic strategy that soft touches the hard teachings of Christ, or the necessary sacrifices that are required to be a disciple of Christ, with the hopes that once you get people in the door then you can give them the full truth. First, who likes being played in a bait-and-switch scheme? This kind of evangelistic strategy shows on our part a lack of confidence in the product. It also fails to respect the person we are evangelizing by not giving them the credit of being able to make a good choice when presented with one. That means we also have to be ok with people walking away. Perhaps now is not the time, or I am not the instrument, for this person coming to Christ.

Now before I conclude I should qualify something. While I believe we should proclaim the fullness of the Gospel at the outset, that does not mean 'beating people over the head with the truth.' Proclaiming the Gospel in a harsh or insensitive manner is in effect an anti-gospel, insofar as it turns people away and can sour any appetite for Christ and His Church. The challenge for us is to proclaim the truth fully but in a way that respects the autonomy, the intelligence, the freedom, and the person with whom we are speaking.
