Hot dish competition recipes to share! Start thinking of your entry for next year! Sea Salt, Cashew, and Milk Chocolate Chip Cookies

Ingredients:

8½ ounces cake flour
8½ ounces bread flour
1¼ teaspoons baking soda
1½ teaspoons baking powder
1½ teaspoons kosher salt
1¼ cups (10 ounces, 2 ½ sticks)
unsalted butter, at room temperature

10 ounces light brown sugar 8 ounces granulated sugar 2 eggs 2 teaspoons vanilla extract 20 ounces milk chocolate chips

1 cup cashews, coarsely chopped Sea salt, for sprinkling

Directions:

1. Whisk together the cake flour, bread flour, baking soda, baking powder and salt into a large bowl and set aside.

2. Cream together the butter and sugars on medium speed until very light, about 5 minutes. Add the eggs one at a time, mixing well after each addition, then add the vanilla. Reduce the mixer speed to low, gradually add the dry ingredients and mix until just combined, 5 to 10 seconds. Using a rubber spatula, fold in the chocolate chips and chopped cashews.

3. Press plastic wrap against the dough and refrigerate for at least 24 hours, up to 72 hours.

4. When ready to bake, preheat oven to 350 degrees. Line a 14 by 14-inch baking sheet with parchment paper.

5. Scoop 3 ½ ounces of dough, roll into a ball and place on the baking sheet. Sprinkle lightly with sea salt and bake until golden brown. 18 to 20 minutes. For smaller cookies, use 1 ¾ ounces of dough and reduce baking time to about 14 minutes total. 6. Transfer the parchment to a wire rack for 10 minutes, then transfer the cookies onto another cooling rack to cool a bit more, until just warm or at room temperature.

From Father Michael Garry

This weekend we congratulate our high school confirmands who will receive the sacrament of Confirmation from Bishop Felton. Confirmation is one of the three Sacraments of Initiation, the other two being Baptism and Holy Eucharist. Grace is a participated share in God's own divine life. So grace is *a living organism*, so to speak, within us. It is <u>born</u> in us at Baptism, it is <u>nourished</u> by the Eucharist, it comes to <u>maturity</u> at Confirmation, it is <u>healed</u>



and refreshed in us by Confession and Anointing of the Sick, and it is at the service of others in the life of the Church through Holy Matrimony and Holy Orders. The seven sacraments are like the faucets in your house, and the infinite grace that Christ merited for us is the water table. The grace of Christ is infinite, but it has to be applied to each one of us concretely. Just as there must be some plumbing to bring the water from the ground into your home, so there must be a channel through which God's infinite store of grace is applied to us individually. The seven sacraments were instituted by Christ Himself. He is the one who determines how grace is given, since He's the one doing the work. The Church, therefore, could not 'invent' new sacraments, nor could she subtract one without doing serious harm to Christ's Mystical Body, the Church. Jesus Christ Himself is the main

celebrant of each sacrament, but He uses the proper minister of each sacrament as an instrument. So it is Christ who baptizes, Christ who confirms, Christ who anoints, Christ who gives Himself in the Eucharist, etc, while the minister of the sacrament is performing it. The life of the Church rightly revolves around the seven sacraments. Let's pray for our confirmands this weekend as they receive this special grace! The Catechism of the Catholic Church (1316) describes Confirmation in this way: *Confirmation perfects Baptismal grace; it is the sacrament which gives the Holy Spirit in order to root us more deeply in the divine filiation, incorporate us more firmly into Christ, strengthen our bond with the Church, associate us more closely with her mission, and help us bear witness to the Christian faith in words accompanied by deeds.* Let's pray for our confirmands this weekend as they receive this special grace!
