

From Father Michael Garry

Last week's bulletin discussed two different aspects of the Mass: the Mass seen as a supper, and the Mass seen as a sacrifice. The point was to show that the Mass, and Catholic liturgy in general, is highly symbolic and is open to multiple points of emphasis. Celebrating the Mass is an art and it requires knowledge of the past, attention, and intention. This week we are reintroducing the rite of the sign of peace after a long hiatus which began with Covid. It's a good opportunity for us to revisit the meaning and significance of the



sign of peace, and a couple points of emphasis the rite has received in the Catholic liturgy tradition. Back in 2005 a number of bishops from all over the world began a formal inquiry as to whether the sign of peace should be moved to a different time in the Mass, for example, at the end of the prayers of the faithful and before the offering of the gifts. Placing the sign of peace before the offering would give the rite the emphasis of reconciling with our neighbor before approaching the altar, per Jesus' exhortation in Matthew 5:23-24: "If you bring your gift to the altar, and there recall that your brother has anything against you, leave your gift there at the altar, go first and be reconciled with your brother, and then come and offer your gift." A formal study of the question ensued and the bishop's conferences around the world were consulted. In 2014 a decision was reached that the rite would remain in its current place after the consecration but before the breaking of the bread. This placement gives the rite the emphasis of the "paschal kiss", an ancient custom of receiving and giving Christ's own peace. The rite occurs just before the breaking of the bread and the entire congregation implores the "Lamb of God" to "grant us peace." So the point of the sign of peace is to receive from Christ, now present in the Eucharist, His own peace, and to offer that to one another in turn. It's important to know that every detail of the Church's liturgy is packed with meaning and significance. The more we understand the Church's intention for each rite in the Mass the more we are able to get out of it. In conclusion, with what has been said it becomes more clear that the sign of peace is not a time to slap hands and say, "Good morning". For perspective, imagine we are standing at the foot of the Cross on Calvary—because that is precisely where we are at every Mass. If our approach to the sign of peace is not appropriate for Calvary it's not appropriate for the Mass either. Let's enter into the sign of peace with intention and reverence this weekend.
