

OLIVE WOOD FROM THE HOLY LAND

Representatives from Bethlehem Christian Families will be with us on June 25 & 26, 2022, to ask for your help and blessing for the native people of the Holy Land in Bethlehem. These families, sixty years ago, made up 18% of the population. Due to recent events in the Middle East, it has caused these families to face devastating economical strain, and caused the population to decrease to less than 2% in the Holy Land. These families have relied on the income from their religious hand carved olive wood artifacts to tourist. So they have come to the USA to try to help support these families by bringing their artifacts here to sell in the USA. All the proceed from sales will be sent back to the families of the Holy Land so that they may be able to keep their homes and provide their families. The last few years were very tough for the Christian families, and this is the only source of income for them.

St. Francis Debt Reduction Campaign

Thank you! The ongoing payments to the Debt Reduction/Campus Completion Campaign commitments are truly making an impact! As communicated earlier, we have made multiple additional principal payments on the mortgage. The three payments were made in October (\$300k) and December (\$150k) of 2021, and an additional payment in January (\$150k) 2022. These payments have saved nearly \$335k in interest expense over the course of the loan – reducing the payments due by almost 7.5 years! The intent of the SF Finance Council is to keep approximately 18 months of mortgage payments in reserve and continue to make additional principal payments with the funds over and above the reserve. If you take a look at the debt summary below you'll see the 'excess' is nearing \$100k. You might be wondering why we haven't made an additional principal payment? More good news follows – read on! Some of these excess funds will be used to initiate and complete Phase II of our construction project – the expansion of the parking lot! We are well on our way with the project plan. The two homes that are behind the church will be razed the week of June 27. Habitat for Humanity has been working on taking out reusable items which will also reduce the amount that will go to the landfill. We do not have definite dates scheduled for the remaining work, but as those dates are confirmed, we will keep you updated on the project plan and costs. Thank you again and we encourage the continued fulfillment of pledges – those from both the remaining commitments from the Building our Future In Christ Campaign (BOFIC) and the Debt Reduction/Campus Completion Campaign. Your generosity is very much appreciated! It is not too late to make a pledge – 53% of parishioner households participated in the original BOFIC campaign and just a little over 25% made a recent pledge for the Debt Reduction/Campus Completion Campaign. From Father Michael Garry

This weekend we celebrate the solemnity of Corpus Christi—Latin for “the Body of Christ”. On this feast we call to mind the great gift of Christ’s Real Presence with us under the appearance of bread and wine. For centuries Catholics have celebrated this day with devotion and splendid display. The Eucharistic procession was an early element in Corpus Christi devotions. The Blessed Sacrament was carried through the town after Mass under its festive ombrellino, or canopy. The procession came to include a version of the Stations of the Cross: stops at various points and, with Eucharist exposed on a simple portable altar, a sung Gospel passage, hymn, harvest blessing, and benediction. Another pious tradition from Italy is called the infiorata, which literally means, “decorated with flowers.” Going back to the 13th century, monasteries had the custom of strewing flowers in the path of the Eucharistic procession on the feast of Corpus Christi. From this practice there evolved in the 17th century the art of designing elaborate carpet panels depicting religious themes. These panels are made from flower pedals, soil, sometimes beans and wood cuttings. It seems that the first flower carpets were made in June of 1625 by the Vatican’s head-florist, Benedetto Drei, and his son Peter. Today, may we celebrate this feast of Corpus Christi with the same love and devotion as is befitting our wonderful Catholic tradition.
