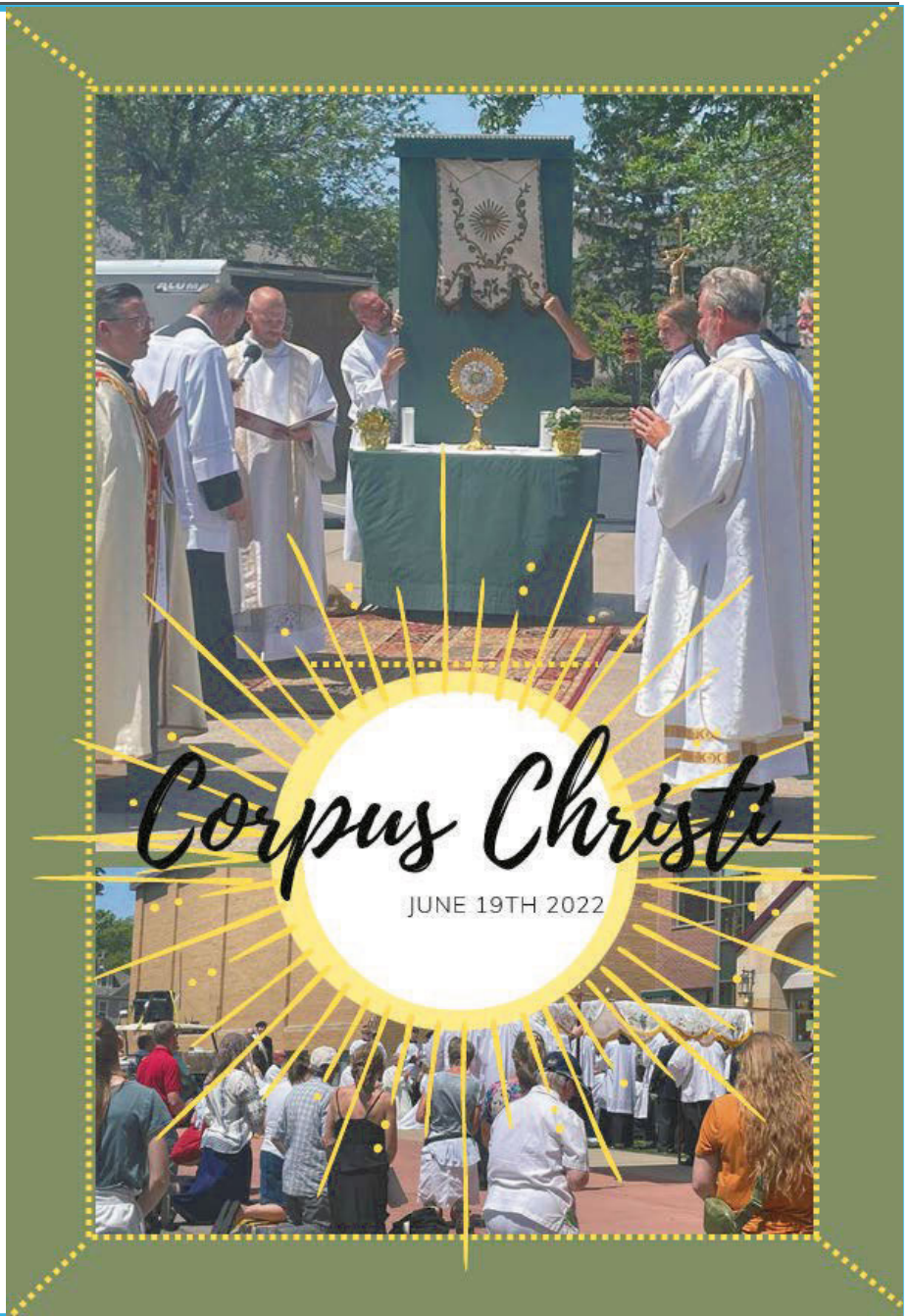

Olive Wood from the Holy Land

Representatives from Bethlehem Christian Families will be with us on June 25 & 26, 2022, to ask for your help and blessing for the native people of the Holy Land in Bethlehem. These families, sixty years ago, made up 18% of the population. Due to recent events in the Middle East, it has caused these families to face devastating economical strain, and caused the population to decrease to less than 2% in the Holy Land. These families have relied on the income from their religious hand carved olive wood artifacts to tourist. So they have come to the USA to try to help support these families by bringing their artifacts here to sell in the USA. All the proceed from sales will be sent back to the families of the Holy Land so that they may be able to keep their homes and provide their families. The last few years were very tough for the Christian families, and this is the only source of income for them.

OUR CHILDREN. OUR FAITH. OUR FUTURE.

From Father Matthew Miller

On Friday, June 24, we celebrated the ordination of two new priests for the Diocese of Duluth. One of the newly ordained is Fr. Scott Padrnos, who is originally from Nisswa, and who is also going to be our new associate come July 13. The other priest is Fr. Daniel Hammer, whose home parish is St. Andrew here in Brainerd. Ordination masses are beautiful and profound, yet what happens during them? I'll not be able to explicate the complete richness of priestly ordinations, yet I'll give a brief overview. It's important to note that the Ordination Mass is the Mass we know and love, yet the ordination of priests happens in the midst of the Mass with several added elements. The "Rite of Ordination" at a priestly ordination Mass takes place between the homily and the intercessions. At this point, those to be ordained (the "ordinandi") make several promises to the ordaining Bishop concerning their faithfulness to their priestly ministry; the culminating promise the ordinandi make is that they will respect and obey their bishop for their whole life. After the promises, the "Litany of Supplication" is chanted, as the Church invokes the saints' intercession for the priests-to-be. As this is chanted, the ordinandi lie prostrate, which is a particularly moving moment. The following 2 elements of the ordination are the 2 necessary elements. First is the "Laying On of Hands," a ritual traced back to the Church's first priests, the Apostles. The bishop, and then all priests in attendance, lay hands on the head of the ordinandi as they kneel before the altar. After this, the second necessary element happens, namely, the "Prayer of Ordination." The ordinandi kneel before the bishop as he prays the prescribed (and theologically rich) prayer of ordination. The conclusion of this prayer is a joy for the ordinandi, as they are now priests once this prayer is over. The new priests then put on priestly vestments, which they receive from a priest whom they choose; normally it is a priest who has influenced them. After, the new priests kneel before the bishop, who anoints their hands with Chrism, that they may sanctify God's people. Next, the new priests receive the paten with bread and a chalice with wine, which denotes the priests' sacramental power to celebrate the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. The "Rite of Ordination" ends with a "Sign of Welcome" as the priests greet their new brother priests. The Mass then proceeds as normal. Again, this overview does not convey the beauty of the liturgical rite; anyone whose been to an ordination will tell you that. I encourage you to go to YouTube, and search "Priestly Ordination" and "Duluth Cathedral," and see the Ordination for yourself. Either way, pray for these two new priests and for more priestly vocations in the Church.
