

OUR CHILDREN. OUR FAITH. OUR FUTURE.

From Father Michael Garry

This weekend we celebrate our nation's historic declaration "that these United Colonies are, and of right ought to be free and independent States, that they are absolved from all allegiance to the British Crown, and that all political connection between them and the State of Great Britain, is and ought to be totally dissolved" (Declaration of Independence). As we reflect on our nation's founding, we would all do well to reread the Declaration of Independence. It's very short, just a page or two, and a good reminder of where



our country came from. Most of it is an enumeration of a couple dozen grievances our representatives had against the British government. But this raises the question for us today: to what did they appeal to claim the actions of the British monarch were unjust? They did not appeal to supreme courts, the decisions of judges, or the law of the land—those were precisely what were at issue. They had to appeal to something else, to some higher law and law-giver, in order to argue that the laws they were under were in fact unjust and illegitimate. In the Declaration of Independence our founding fathers appealed to "Laws of Nature and of Nature's God". If we are going to preserve this union we must once again learn to appeal to "the Laws of Nature and of Nature's God" in our civil discourse. Enshrining something in law doesn't change its moral quality; it is moral or immoral regardless of its legal status, as we saw at our nation's founding. Another example of something enshrined in law but morally reprehensible is abortion. We are especially grateful on this Independence Day that the controversial Supreme Court decision Roe vs. Wade was overruled just over a week ago. So we know what makes something legal or illegal, but what make something moral or immoral? By what standard is morality to be judged by? Many today, either explicitly or implicitly, hold to a crass moral relativism, which states that all morality is relative to each person's private fancy. But this is obviously no way to govern a nation. The only objective measure is the laws of nature and of nature's God.
