

# From Father Michael Garry

One of the hallmarks of conversion in Christ is that we cannot help but desire to bring others to experience the good news of the Gospel as well. There are many Gospel fruits borne in our parishes, praise be to God. One of those fruits is the missionary spirit among our youth. This week I'd like to feature three of our missionaries: Jaclyn Johnson will be on mission again for Saint Paul's Outreach (SPO) in Kansas City, MO. SPO has around 204 missionaries in 46 households on



college campuses nationwide. The missionaries form centers of authentic Catholic community and provide a necessary point of contact for students to encounter Christ in a meaningful way. Bishop Andrew Cozzens, the new bishop of Crookston, MN, has often spoken of how SPO changed his life. You can contact Jaclyn at (218) 839-1485 or jaclyn.johnson@spo.org. Kelsey Stroot will be on mission with the Fellowship of Catholic University Students (FOCUS). Similar to SPO, the mission field of FOCUS is college campuses. They have around 800 missionaries spread over 205 locations. The missionaries work with college students, inspiring and equipping them to live Christ-centered lives. Riah Stroot just graduated from high school and has decided that before she enters college she will live as a missionary in Cambodia. She will be a missionary associate with Diocese of Duluth natives Nic & Jacelyn Davidson and their seven children. Their nonprofit organization is called Freely Given Inc. You can check out their website at www.freelygiveninc.org. Riah will be living with and serving people in need in Cambodia. Her goal is to bring the good news of the Gospel to the people, support the Davidsons in whatever ways they need, and to grow in her own relationship with Christ. All three of these missionaries would love to hear from you and tell you about their mission. I encourage everyone to reach out to these young women, hear their story, and catch the missionary fire.
