Year End Giving 2021

Thank you for your continued generosity in supporting Immaculate Heart of Mary, both in prayer and financially so that together we can continue making the name of Jesus Christ known and loved. 2021 continues to be a year of financial hardship for many, and we are so grateful for your sacrificial giving.

The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act Of 2020 allows for taxpayers who don't itemize to take a charitable deduction of up to \$300 for cash contributions made in 2021 to qualifying organizations, including our parish. Married-filling-jointly taxpayers will get an above-the-line deduction of up to \$600.The CARES Act also temporarily suspends limits on charitable contributions. You can learn more at *irs.gov*. Here is how to give a recurring or one-time gift:

- Electronic Donations can be set up through the secure <u>VANCO giving page.</u>
- Mail in your usual collection envelopes to our parish at 13505 Excelsior Blvd, Minnetonka MN 55345.
- Use the Christmas envelope in your giving packet or on-line giving to make a special Christmas donation.
- IRA Distributions: Please consult your tax advisor to make a direct transfer from your IRA to IHM. This option may be particularly beneficial if you don't itemize deductions on your tax return.
- Stock Contributions: If you have appreciated stock this year, you may realize a tax break by donating to IHM. Consult your tax advisor to address your situation.
- Employer Matching Funds: You may wish to consult with your employer to determine if a matching gift from your company can double the value of your contribution to our parish.

Please note donations must be received in the office by Noon on December 31, 2021 or post-marked by December 31, 2021 in order to count toward 2021 deductions for tax reporting purposes. Donations received on January 1, 2022 or later will be credited to 2022 giving regardless of the check date, except those received through the mail with a postmark of 2021.






