



A Journey to Joy! Bringing Scripture to Life with Drama and Humor. Frank, a Catholic, has advanced degrees in Religion and American Studies, but may best be known for his many roles on television. His performances are funny, insightful and riveting. January 5, Luke: Stories on the Road

They're some of the most famous stories ever told, stories we have heard many times . . . or have we? Join Jesus on the road and be as surprised as the disciples were to hear the stories that Jesus is telling — and what you've been missing.

In an evening that is both entertaining and eye-opening, Runyeon performs the famous parables in Luke's travel narrative, and then pauses to reflect on how we hear each story-

and miss what it is really saying.

Runyeon does what Luke himself did. He starts with Jesus speaking in the synagogue at Nazareth, and takes us on a journey to Jerusalem, so we can hear these famous stories in order, and begin to hear what Jesus was really saying: stories addressed to us personally... about our lives, here and now. Includes stories of the Rich Man and Lazarus, The Prodigal Son, The Good Samaritan, Zachaeus, Pray "Father", and more.



January 6, Sermon on the Mount

Few parts of the Bible are as famous as the Sermon on the Mount. It includes the Lord's Prayer, the Golden Rule... But did you know: it also includes a story?

Runyeon sets the famous Sermon in a revealing new setting: as told by the apostle Matthew to the church in Antioch, shortly after the Roman army has burned Jerusalem to the ground...

In this dramatic setting, suddenly the lines heard so often have new meaning. And the very human stories of the people which Matthew may have addressed come to life: There are the livestock merchant, the silk trader, the Deacon who just can't stop talking, the seamstress who spends all her money on her clothes, and many others...

As Runyeon moves around the church, retelling the sermon, there is surprising humor and very powerful drama. In the end, all those present have the sense that this sermon is about them, in some mysterious way... that they, too must decide, as did the crowd on the mountain, what they will go do now ... for they have their own part to play in this "story."



January 7, Hollywood vs Faith

Frank Runyeon admits he has always felt torn between the world of the media and the world of faith. He thinks much of America is. We go from our cellphone to church, and then back to our cellphone (or TV). We want to live in both worlds. But is that really possible?

Over the past 30 years, as the way of life embodied by the mass media has moved further and further from the Christian way of life, Runyeon confides he has struggled to make the right

choices. He speaks with humor about that struggle, and shares the fruits of lessons he has learned—from his studies at Princeton to working opposite Meg Ryan on the soaps and in movies, from hosting comedy talk shows on L.A. radio to studying at Yale Divinity, from 25 years touring America (and over 3,000 churches) to 30 years as a parent.

Runyeon identifies the four biggest distortions in the mirror which Hollywood holds up to our lives, a set of false beatitudes. He suggests a surprisingly simple answer to how we can live faithfully as Christians —while still enjoying the best of the media. He may change the way you (and your kids) see the media forever.
