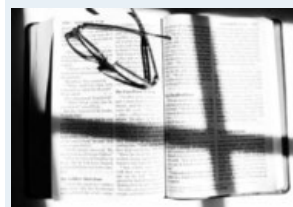
Additional Mass Time Sundays 7:15 am

Mass Intentions

What does it mean to have a Mass “offered” for someone?

A Mass may be offered for several reasons:

- In thanksgiving, such as blessings received.
- For the intentions of another person, such as on a birthday.
- Or, as is most common, for the repose of the soul of someone who has died. There are infinite graces that flow from the Sacrifice of the Mass which benefit one’s soul.

The intention of the Mass is also determined by various factors. The Church may stipulate the particular intention. For example, all pastors are required to offer one Mass on Sunday for the intentions of the living and deceased parishioners of a parish. This Mass is “the People of the Parish” you hear the lector mention. A priest may also have his own particular intention in offering a Mass, such as the repose of the soul of his parents. Finally, a person may ask to have a Mass offered for a particular intention. Usually a \$10 stipend is suggested for offering the Mass, which thereby in justice creates an obligation which must be satisfied.

Would you like to have a Mass offered for someone or a personal intention? We currently have a **few open Daily Masses in February, as well as open Daily and Sunday Mass times in March and the following months.** If you would like to schedule Masses, please stop by or call the Parish Office at 952-935-1432. Masses are scheduled on a first come first served basis.

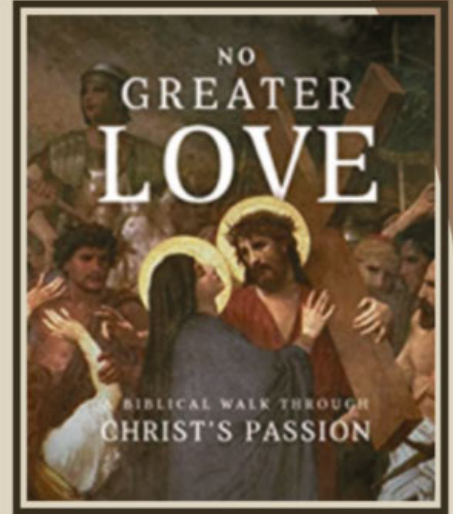
