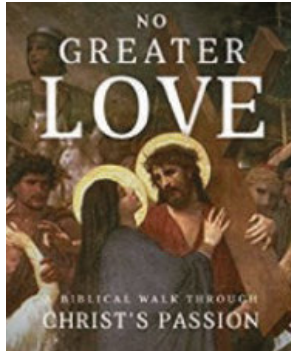

Franciscan Retreat Center

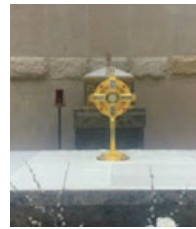
