The month of November is a very important month for our faith as it is the month of the Holy Souls. The belief of the Church has always been that, when we die, if we are free from mortal sin but still have attachments or desire for sin, this must be purified after death. The place of this purification we know as Purgatory.

Purgatory is a place where there is suffering and purification. This suffering is not final though, since every soul in Purgatory will eventually go to heaven. We have the ability, through our prayers, to assist souls on their journey through Purgatory. We can also have Masses offered for the deceased and this will also be of a great assistance to them.

Visiting the cemetery is a beautiful custom in the week following All Souls' Day. It is possible to gain a Plenary Indulgence for the soul of a deceased person each day in the week following All Saints Day by visiting a cemetery and performing the prescribed prayers and works. You can learn more about this by simply doing an internet search for "All Souls Day Indulgence." Praying for the deceased can be a gesture of love for our deceased relatives and friends, and November is a month when we especially remember this reality.

November begins, of course, with the celebration of the saints in heaven, All Saints' Day. This is an important celebration, and so much so, that its a Holy Day of obligation. Please see the bulletin for Mass times.
