ANUNCIOS en ESPAÑOL



BAUTISMO

Padre Jairo Congote

Esta época es una excelente oportunidad para reflexionar sobre nuestro propio bautismo y su significado. El día más importante de su vida fue el día de su bautizo. Ese fue el día en el que usted fue moldeado, fue hecho como Jesús quien es sacerdote, profeta y rey. En los bautizos se usa el aceite para la unción, el santo crisma que es la manera como los reyes eran ungidos y declarados reyes. Todas las personas que se bautizan son ungidas, son pequeños Mesías, son pequeños cristos. Esto es sacerdote, profeta y rey. Esto es parte de las enseñanzas de la iglesia. Se puede ver como cada cristiano participa de estos tres oficios, tareas, o ministerios.

Que significa que uno sea SACERDOTE, un sacerdote es aquel que ora por otros, intercede por otros y lleva a cabo o realiza sacrificios por otros. Adán, Noé, Abraham, Jacob, Moisés son ejemplos de sacerdotes. En el templo los sacerdotes judíos realizaban sacrificios. Los sacerdotes son mediadores, son amigos de Dios y de los humanos, como que unen la humanidad y la divinidad. Usted puede decir un momento yo no he sido ordenado sacerdote, es verdad, pero usted recibió el crisma, el aceite en el bautismo, es decir que usted fue ungido como sacerdote. Ser sacerdote significa que usted es una persona de oración, en especial, una persona que ora por los demás, que intercede por los demás. Usted debe orar por el pueblo de Dios. Dios a través de nosotros y de nuestras oraciones canaliza las cosas. Por eso es importante preguntarnos si oramos, si rezamos con frecuencia. Padres, oran ustedes por sus hijos? Hijos, oran ustedes por sus padres, sus profesores, sus amigos? Maridos, oran ustedes por sus esposas? Esposas bautizadas, oran ustedes por sus esposos? Familias bautizadas, oran ustedes antes de tomar los alimentos? En la casa y en público cuando comen por fuera? Padres bendicen y oran por sus hijos antes de que ellos se vayan a dormir y antes de salir a la escuela? Todos ustedes miembros de la familia asisten a misa? el lugar por excelencia, el primordial, donde ejercemos nuestras funciones en la liturgia. Por eso el Concilio invita a una participación activa, consciente y fructuosa en la misa. Usted estará respondiendo a su llamado sacerdotal de bautismo cuando usted viene a misa y ora y participa activamente. Muchos católicos cuando no vienen a misa están negándose a esta responsabilidad primordial de ser sacerdotes pues es un privilegio al que se niegan. Esta usted ejercitando su sacerdocio? Ora usted por otros?

PROFETA. Todos los bautizados somos profetas. Un profeta es el que habla por Dios. Su tarea era hablar la palabra de Dios, fuera bienvenida o recibida o no. Casi nunca era bienvenida la palabra de Dios en los profetas. Los que hablan por Dios no son con frecuencia muy populares porque hablan cosas que a la gente no le interesa o no aceptan. La palabra de Dios debe estar en sus labios con frecuencia. Ustedes no han sido ordenados para predicar como lo hago yo, pero por el bautismo ustedes son profetas. Ustedes se quedan cortos cuando hacen de su religión algo privado, algo íntimo solo para ustedes. Pero el profeta está llamado a hablar la palabra de Dios en público. Pero debemos hablar de Dios y de su centralidad e importancia en nuestras vidas. Debemos incluso llevar, lucir signos de nuestra fe, mostrarlos en nuestros lugares de trabajo. Yo me pregunto si la gente en los lugares donde ustedes trabajan, saben ellos de alguna manera que ustedes son católicos. Ellos saben cuál es su religión? Obviamente ustedes deben predicar con la ejemplaridad y belleza de sus vidas, pero si la gente con la que trabaja no saben su fe, es porque ustedes la llevan muy personal, muy escondida y no están cumpliendo su llamado a ser profetas. Deben saber dar razón de la esperanza que habita en usted. Deben leer de espiritualidad y teología, deben conocer la fe y estudiarla. Padres ustedes le enseñan la fe a sus hijos? Saben ellos como rezar? Conocen la importancia de la misa? Saben de los santos y doctores de la iglesia? Entienden la liturgia? Si no es así, ustedes no han sido profetas para sus hijos. Los privilegios del bautismo se deben llevar con responsabilidad. Ser profeta es anunciar y enseñar la fe.

REY. Un rey es alguien que lleva a los otros a Dios y organiza las cosas para que la gente encuentre su misión. Todos los bautizados somos Reyes en Cristo por el bautismo. Cuando usted le da a alguien buen consejo en la vida espiritual, cuando los dirige a los fines que Dios quiere que alcance, usted estará actuando como rey, como líder. Cuando los padres se aseguran que los hijos están por el camino de la santidad y la van a buscar y alcanzar, están actuando como reyes. La responsabilidad primordial de los padres es asegurarse que los hijos estén creciendo en santidad, por su supuesto que les deben enseñar a socializar, a jugar deportes, pero gobernar a la familia, es ayudar a los hijos a encontrar su misión en la vida. Ayudarles a encontrar lo que Dios quiere que hagan es actuar como reyes. Cuando alguien toma roles específicos aquí en la iglesia, está actuando como Rey, por eso la importancia de dejarse guiar. Cuando alguien está organizando un grupo de oración está actuando como rey. Por eso la importancia de esta fiesta es participar y pues también contemplar el bautismo de Jesús. Ejercer nuestros ministerios como sacerdote, profeta y rey es la mejor manera de honrar al Señor.
