LOS FRUTOS DE LA PAZ DE CRISTO

En el evangelio observamos la preparación gradual que reciben los discípulos para empezar a afrontar el futuro en el que la relación con Jesús no va a tener la dimensión de presencia física que había tenido

hasta entonces. De cara a la nueva presencia espiritual y dinámica de Jesús, será indispensable y muy necesario contar con los siguientes tres elementos: amor, confianza y tranquilidad. El que las tiene, cuenta con la presencia de las Tres Personas divinas.

"El que ama cumplirá mi palabra", dice el Señor, subrayando la relación entre el amor y el cumplimiento de la palabra, porque el amor verdadero es mucho más que un sentimiento afectivo; el amor es sobre todo una conducta o manera de comportarse, ya que "obras son amores y no buenas razones". El amor de Jesús es la piedra angular de todo edificio espiritual. Jesús nos amó y nos hizo hermanos suyos y por ello nos sigue amando. Nosotros estamos llamados a trabajar por crear hermandad, amándonos los unos a los otros.

La paz de Cristo es una paz activa y vital que solamente Dios puede darla o inspirarla dentro del corazón; es el fruto de un compromiso y de una lucha por ser fieles a los planes de Dios para nuestro mundo. Esa paz produce frutos de amor, perdón, generosidad, paciencia, alegría y aceptación de la voluntad de Dios. Es la plenitud del SHALOM que se deseaban los judíos al saludarse. Esa paz no es enturbiada y disminuida por las vicisitudes adversas de la vida, ya que el cristiano está en las manos del Padre y siempre podrá tener en mente las palabras de Santa teresa de Ávila: Nada de turbe, nada te espante, todo se pasa, Dios no se muda, la paciencia todo lo alcanza quien a Dios tiene, nada de falta, solo Dios basta.

La paz de Cristo en su Iglesia, desde los comienzos fue el fruto de un compromiso de amor en favor de los creyentes menos apreciados. En la Iglesia no hay que confundir la unidad con la uniformidad. Los demás no necesitan ser como tú para ser perfectos.

DEACONS

At a parish council meeting, our pastor mentioned the need for deacons. It is something I am considering. How do I know if I have a vocation? What steps should I take next?

Any and all gifts that the Holy Spirit gives to the church are for the good of the community. As members of the Body of Christ, what one member does affects all. What the body does also affects each member. A vocation or call to ministry is tested and verified by the church. Through prayer, instruction, and service, a vocation is tested, and then acknowledged by the official call to orders or to service.

If you are considering becoming a deacon, the first step would be to talk to your pastor. He will be able to give you more specific information on the program in your diocese, what is expected of you, and how you apply. You might also begin to see a spiritual director, someone who can help you with your faith journey and vocation discernment. They do so by focusing on prayer, your relationship with God, and spiritual practices. Finally, you'll need to see the diocesan vocation director in charge of deacons to apply. Best wishes!


