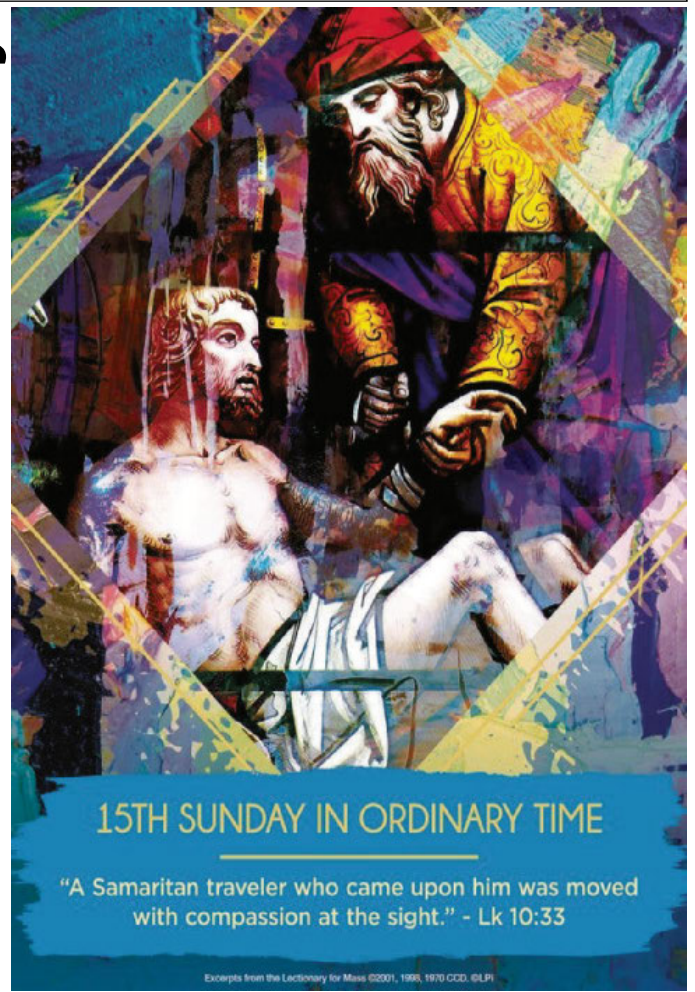

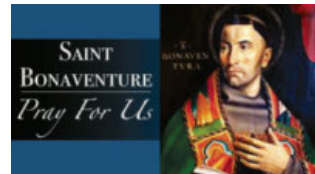

EL BUEN SAMARITANO

Padre Jairo Congote

A la pregunta clave sobre qué hacer para
obtener la salvación, Jesús ofrece la respues-
ta que conocemos: “Anda y haz tú lo mis-
mo”. Para entrar en la vida hay que amar, compadeciéndose
del sufrimiento de los pobres y necesitados, pasando a la
acción, para que la compasión se haga realidad y sea eficaz:
“Ama y vivirás”, porque amar es vivir.

La pregunta del fariseo sobre quien era su prójimo era
una pregunta fácil de responder, pero lo difícil era saber
hacerse prójimo de los demás. Uno se hace prójimo cuando
se acerca y aproxima a otra persona en su necesidad, ha-
ciéndola centro de interés y de su acción. Uno no debe es-
perar a que le pidan ayuda o le den una lista de familias o
personas necesitadas de la comunidad; debe buscar activa-
mente a esas personas, porque muchas veces los verdaderos
necesitados nunca aparecen en esas listas.

Los oyentes de Jesús se debieron sorprender porque el
tercero que pasó por el camino y que fue el modelo de con-
ducta a imitar, no fue fariseo o un doctor de la Ley sino un
odiado y despreciado samaritano. El samaritano fue salva-
dor del pobre porque al verlo se compadeció de él, tenía
compasión; hasta invirtió sus bienes en caridad, pagando
por adelantado y de cara al futuro, prometiendo hacerse
cargo de los demás gastos.

La compasión es el móvil de salvación; el compasivo se
convierte en salvador. Hoy nosotros encontramos a muchos
caídos a la vera del camino: enfermos, desempleados, obre-
ros mal pagados, indocumentados, drogadictos, divorcia-
dos, alcohólicos. A veces vemos a algunos buenos samari-
tanos que extienden la mano para tocar y confortar a los
caídos, pero hay muchos otros que, al ver a los caídos al
lado del camino, pasan de largo, porque van distraídos o
creen tener cosas más importantes, o porque tienen miedo a
comprometerse.

Muchas veces pasamos mientras los ladrones están despo-
jando al pobre caído y ¿qué hacemos? Dios es nuestro Gran
prójimo, siempre cerca de nosotros, que nos ha dejado su
imagen en las demás personas. Al final de la parábola, Je-
sús devuelve la pregunta original: “¿Quién fue el prójimo
del hombre caído? El que tuvo compasión y se le acercó.
En línea con la pregunta de Jesús, nosotros hacemos el bien
a los demás, no porque ellos son buenos o cristianos y son
agradecidos, sino porque nosotros queremos ser buenos
cristianos, agradecidos a nuestro Padre quien nos mueve a
acercarnos a nuestros hermanos.

Hoy podríamos preguntarnos qué principio o lema guía
nuestra vida. El de los ladrones era “lo tuyo es mío”; el del
sacerdote y el levita era “lo mío es mío”, el del samaritano
era “lo mío es tuyo”. Desde el comienzo de la creación,
Dios nos ha dicho de muchos modos: “Lo mío es tuyo”.
Dios ha puesto todo lo suyo en nuestras manos.

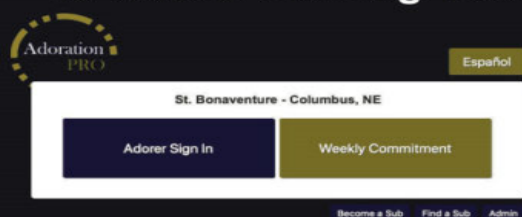

FEAST OF ST. BONAVENTURE

Do you ever get stuck with the tough jobs? It's well known that the Franciscan Order was incredibly influential throughout history. But one of the most challenging times for a new movement is surviving the death of the founder. Bonaventure joined the Franciscan Order almost two decades after the passing of St. Francis. Initially, the young man's theological insights earned him a prime faculty position at the University of Paris. More than his academic skill, however, he was known for his deep devotion to Christ. He was elected the General Minister of the Franciscan Order, right in the thick of controversies. Some friars had conflicting views of how to interpret St. Francis' poverty as the order grew. Others started a new heresy, saying that the Franciscan Order began a new era of the Holy Spirit, replacing the era of Jesus and the authority of the Church. St. Bonaventure weathered these crises with grace, restructuring the order when necessary and offering a more organized perspective on the insights of St. Francis.

What Jesus Doesn't Say

"If Jesus wanted us to (fill in the blank), he would have said so."

We hear this argument applied to every controversial topic under the sun — and even some not-so-controversial topics, too. Whenever someone is trying to make a case for a decision they have already made, they call in Jesus' scriptural silence on the matter as their expert, unimpeachable witness.

And sure, there's much Jesus doesn't talk about in the Gospels. But by this logic, we would have to assume that Jesus doesn't care, for instance, if we drive well over the speed limit (he doesn't discuss cars and highways in the Bible) or what we do online (he never mentions the Internet or websites at all!), when we know that certainly is just not the case.

Like the scholar of the Jewish law who challenges Jesus to define who exactly his "neighbor" is, we can argue semantics all we want. But if we rest in prayer and look deep into our hearts, we know what path we need to take, and it's usually not the easy one.

I find that I do this plenty in ways that are far more subtle. I lament that the situation facing me is not sufficiently "black and white." I become frustrated by the shades of moral grey and toss up my hands, claiming I don't know what the right answer is, insisting that I can't be blamed for the ramifications of whatever decision I make.

What I need to be doing in these situations is asking God for His guidance, even if it makes me nervous. I need to be like the scholar. He was brave enough to ask, even though I think he knew he wouldn't particularly like the answer. Let's strive for that same courage.
