#### ST. BONAVENTURE

Meister Eckhart asks, "Who is the man whose prayers God always hears?" He answers, "God hears the man who appeals to God as God. When, however, man appeals to God, hoping for some worldly good, he is not appealing to God at all, but to what he is asking of God. He is trying to make God his servant. On this point, St. Augustine says: 'You pray to what you love, for true whole prayer is nothing but love!' Thus, we pray to what we love, and no one rightly prays to God but he who prays for God and has nothing on his mind but God." We struggle with what we want God to do and how we want our praver validated. Meister Eckhart is correct. We often want God to be our servant. We further struggle with trusting that God knows what we need and that His will is best.

God's will is not some predetermined outcome of events that we must simply suggest. "Thy will be done" is not an invocation beckoning us to accept a particular state of affairs passively. Rather, it is the humble and confident placement of ourselves in the presence of the God we seek, whom we call "Father." We must remember that God is the God of life and *light. It is from nothing that God brings something and from* the darkness that God brings life. Prayer allows us to seek the One we love with the assurance that all will be well regardless of what course the events of our lives take. God is not about passive submission but the humble trust of love.

That's what makes the Lord's Prayer the perfect prayer. It provides us with proper disposition and focus, putting in line all of the essential relationships of our lives. It celebrates and fosters the ever-deepening relationship of trust we have with our Creator. It also calls us to keep open the doors of love between our brothers and sisters with the power that comes with forgiveness. If in one's darkest hour they can find the resolve to fervently pray this perfect prayer of Jesus' conviction, then there is no doubt that God will hear their plea. reach out in love, and bring them ever closer to His heart. What more does one need to weather the storms of life besides faith, hope, and love? These are God's most perfect gifts and all we really need.

#### ORACIÓN E INTERCESIÓN Padre Jairo Congote

Los discípulos, al oír orar a Jesús, quisieron imitarle, ya que debieron ver en la oración de Jesús algo muy especial que ellos no tenían ni sentían. El Padrenuestro, más que una fórmula de oración, es un modelo de

oración. En cada frase de esta oración hacemos una petición a Dios, es necesario tener presente que al mismo tiempo nos hacemos una petición semejante o un desafío a nosotros mismos. Lo que le pedimos a Dios que haga es lo que nosotros tenemos que hacer con su ayuda: que santifiquemos su Nombre; que hagamos su voluntad; que perdonemos; que evitemos las tentaciones y los peligros. Es importante que nosotros hagamos del Padrenuestro una parte activa de nuestra vida como cristianos. Toda la vida de Jesús fue una vivencia del Padre nuestro, especialmente en su pasión, al aceptar la voluntad del Padre en la agonía de Getsemaní, al perdonar a sus enemigos, al prometer la entrada en el reino al ladrón arrepentido y al ponerse confiadamente en las manos del Padre.

El Padrenuestro expresa los principales sentimientos, deseos y peticiones del corazón cristiano que reza, en plural, en solidaridad con sus hermanos y hermanas, porque el Padrenuestro es la oración por excelencia de la Familia de Dios. La Iglesia reza el Padrenuestro en todos los actos litúrgicos pues contiene los principios que deben guiar la vida del cristiano. Comienza con un énfasis en Dios y en sus planes para luego hablar de nuestras necesidades, vistas desde la perspectiva de Dios. Dios es llamado "Padre". Esto expresa una confianza y cariño muy grandes. Dios es santificado cuando, por el amor y la práctica de la justicia su Nombre es bendecido y respetado por los suyos. Su Reino viene entre nosotros cuando, por obediencia hacemos su voluntad, especialmente ayudar a los pobres y necesitados. Al pedirle que nos de nuestro Pan de cada día, nos encomendamos a su Providencia, ya que Dios conoce nuestras necesidades materiales y espirituales; el Pan Eucarístico es el alimento diario que más necesitamos. Al pedir a Dios que nos perdone, lo hacemos con humildad, ya que reconocemos nuestras diferencias en nuestras relaciones con los demás. Finalmente, pedimos a Dios que no nos deje caer en la tentación, porque reconocemos nuestra debilidad y sabemos que él es la esperanza de nuestra salvación.

En el antiguo testamento, en sus primeras presentaciones, la oración es un diálogo confiado con Dios, alabándole, intercediendo por el pueblo, pidiéndole favores y perdón. Son bien conoci-

dos los diálogos de Abrahán y de Moisés con Dios. Abrahán es el modelo de orante intercesor; él era el amigo de Dios. Abrahán se dirigió a Dios con plena confianza y en solidaridad con los demás. Aprendemos por el siervo de Señor que uno solo, con su sacrificio y justicia, traerá la salvación a todo el mundo; ese será Jesús quien nos dejó este preciso legado de la oración a nuestro Padre celestial.
