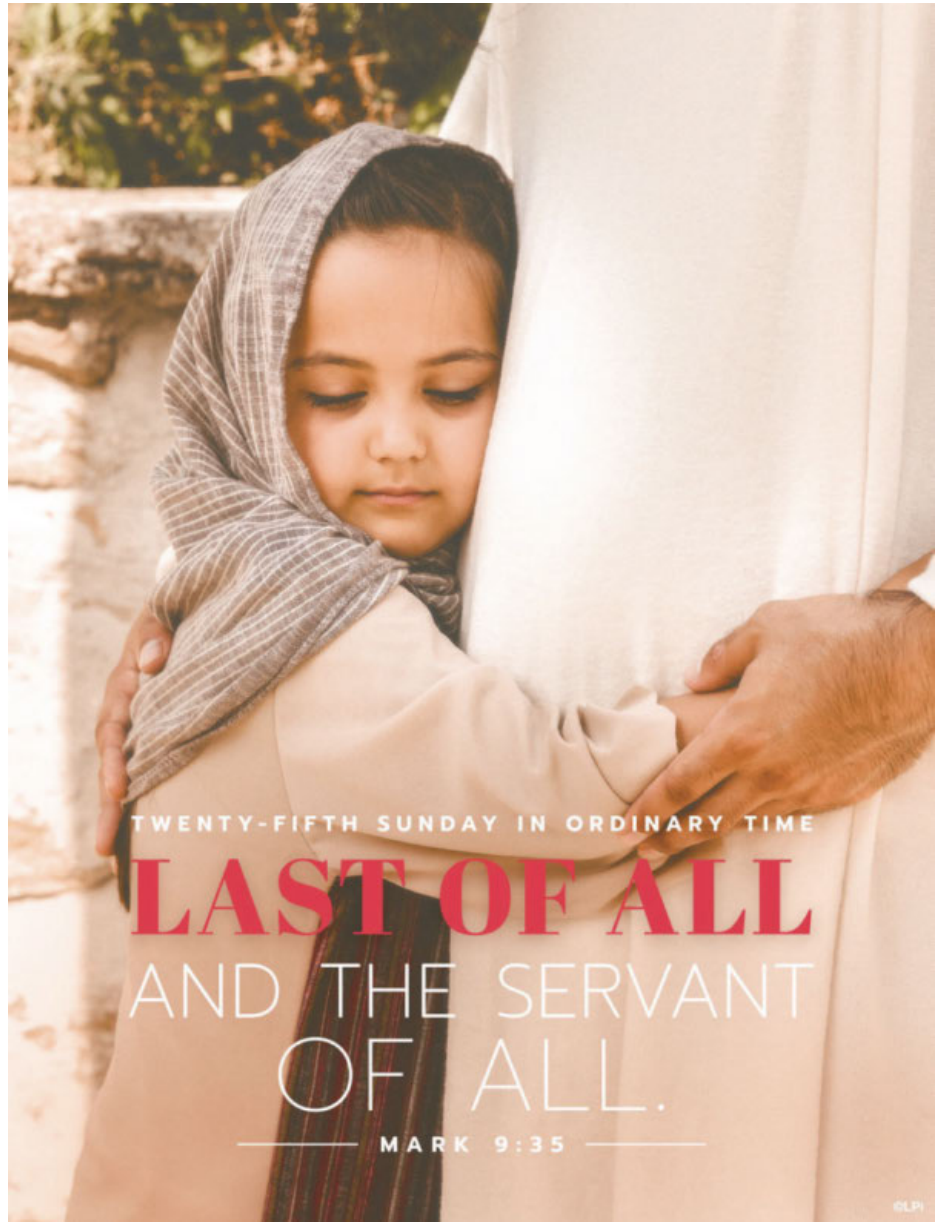

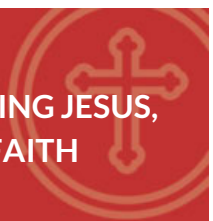

### A MESSAGE FROM FATHER ROZA



#### CONGRATULATIONS TO OUR 2024 SPIRIT OF ST.

#### VINCENT de PAUL WINNERS: JOHN & KATHY GENTRY

John Gentry went through the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults in 1994-95 -- and he has been a part of the program ever since. From speaker to table leader to sponsor, and now program director, he has helped prepare 469 adults to join the Church at Easter. This year marks his 30<sup>th</sup> with the program and 16<sup>th</sup> as director, guiding a class of 19. His wife Kathy joined him 12 years ago in this important ministry.

Deacon Don and Mary Clausen led the program when John took instruction. "They were really instrumental for me," John said. "He was a mentor and now both are really good friends." When Deacon Don retired from the program, he suggested to Fr. Dan Kampschneider that John take over. "When I met with Fr. Dan, I was a bit apprehensive since my knowledge was nowhere near Deacon Don's. But I told Fr. Dan that I'd give it one year and see what happens. And this is my 16th year in charge, so I guess we're doing OK."

Their involvement, John said, "has been great for our faith and our growth in our faith." They are grateful for the many people they've met and who have stayed in their lives. And they are proud to introduce their classes to the Catholic faith as well as to the Catholic community at SVdP. The couple estimate they devote about 11 months each year to OCIA, planning the curriculum, leading classes and Sunday instruction. What keeps them coming back? Kathy: "It's one little thing that we can do to help bring people closer to God. We always stress that this is a journey; in fact, the symbol of our class is a suitcase. This journey doesn't end with OCIA. It's a lifelong journey in your relationship with God. The destination is heaven." John said simply, "We just love doing it."

While they are honored and humbled by this award, the Gentrys emphasized they are not in this alone. "We're passionate about this, but give credit to the Holy Spirit," Kathy said. "And to our team." Team members facilitate table discussions, serve as sponsors, help with retreats and act as role models. John added, "We also are so blessed to have our deacons and priests; they help teach our classes and lead our retreats. They are such a good support system for us and for OCIA."

John and Kathy, both now retired, moved to Omaha 40 years ago from Indianapolis. They have two children: Daughter Lauren is director of campus ministry at Cardinal Spellman High School in the Bronx. Son Scott is a pharmacist in Phoenix. John said both children are active in their respective parishes. He'd like to credit OCIA in part for their strong faith lives: "Knowing that it was something big to us, maybe it rubbed off on them."

## BECOME A LECTOR OR EMHC

### WOULD YOU LIKE TO SERVE AS AN EMHC OR A LECTOR AT MASS?

Participating in the Mass as an EMHC (Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion) or a LECTOR (Minister of the Word) are meaningful ways to serve the parish and grow in faith. EMHCs assist the clergy in the distribution of the Body and Blood of Christ at Communion time. Some EMHCs take Holy Communion to the sick and shut-ins as well. LECTORS have been entrusted with the important task of making the Word of God come alive by proclaiming it for the assembly.

#### Am I an eligible candidate?

Eligible candidates are the following:

- fully initiated,
- practicing Catholics,
- in good standing,
- who have a parish affiliation,
- demonstrated responsibility and commitment to service, and are
- at least a rising junior in high school.

#### How can I become an EMHC or LECTOR?

In order to become an EMHC or LECTOR, you must do the following:

- Complete the on-line Archdiocesan training session.
- Attend the parish Mandation Mass: New EMHCs/LECTORS will receive a special Mandation blessing by Fr. Roza during a morning Mass, TBD.
- Attend a simple parish-specific training session will also be important to attend after Mandation. DATE TBD.

#### What if I have been mandated in a former parish or diocese?

We invite individuals who have been mandated by the Archdiocese of Omaha or their former dioceses to become an EMHC or LECTOR for our parish.

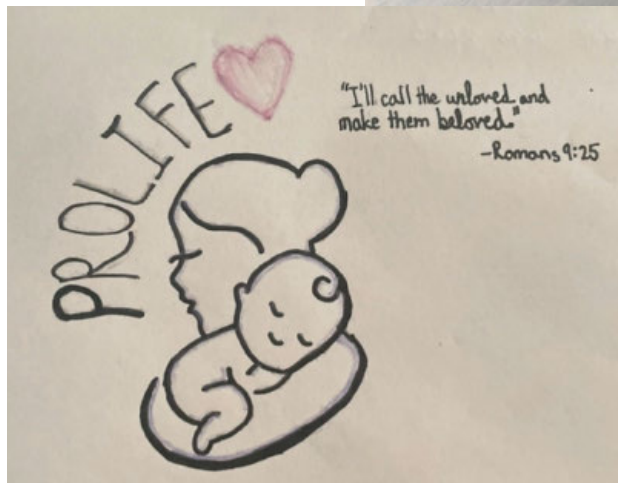
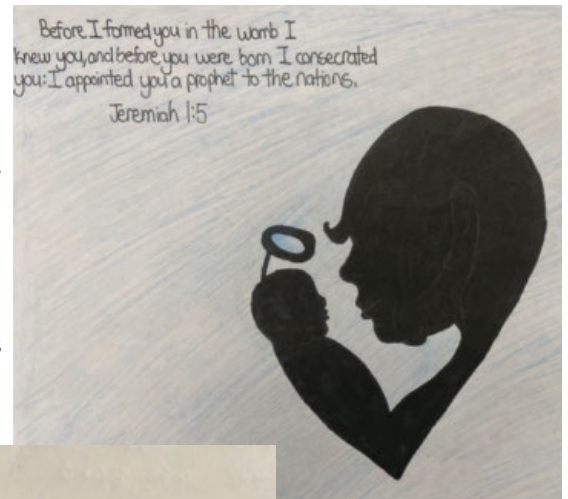

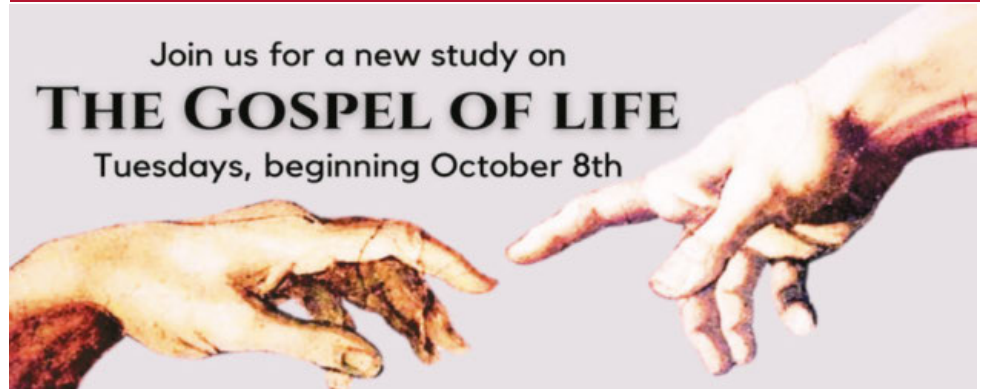
A Note from Hannah Keisling:
