## FROM FR. RAY



I received an Easter Week letter from Bishop Joensen. He formally accepted my request to retire as of July 14, 2022. He has also formally named Father Joe Pins, currently the pastor of St. Joseph Parish in Des Moines, as my successor.

The past two weekends we celebrated the first communion for 136 of our people. Please pray for

our second graders receiving their first communions this week and last week.

We are kicking off the Ignite campaign. This diocesan appeal is meant to raise \$45,000,000 to support our diocesan Catholic schools, seminarian's education, priest's retirement and parish support. Our parish share is \$3,650,000. If we reach our goal, \$550,000 will be returned to the parish. We are still in need of volunteers to help us reach out to our parishioners to raise this amount. Pope Francis' "Urbi et Orbi" message for Easter: "Our eyes, too, are incredulous on this Easter of war. We have seen all too much blood, all too much violence. Our hearts, too, have been filled with fear and anguish, as so many of our brothers and sisters have had to lock themselves away in order to be safe from bombing. We struggle to believe that Jesus is truly risen, that he has truly triumphed over death. Could it be an illusion? A figment of our imagination? No, it is not an illusion! Today, more than ever, we hear echoing the Easter proclamation so dear to the Christian East: 'Christ is risen! He is truly risen!"

In the gospel for the Third Sunday of Easter Jesus appears to the apostles as they were fishing on the Sea of Galilee. After an unsuccessful night of fishing he tells them to cast their nets on the right side of the boat; when they did this they had a catch of 153 "large fish." When they recognized him and ate with him Jesus asked Peter three times if he loved him and after three positive assents he instructed Peter to "follow" him and "feed his lambs [and] tend his sheep." We too are fed by Jesus and sent by Jesus.

"When they had finished breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, 'Simon, son of John, do you love me more than these?' He said to him, 'Yes, Lord, you know that I love you.' He said to him, 'Feed my lambs.' He then said to him a second time, 'Simon, son of John, do you love me?' He said to him, 'Yes, Lord, you know that I love you.' He said to him, 'Tend my sheep.'" John 21:15-16


