

Most rural schools use pit toilets, which are holes in wooden structures that drop waste into a pit dug deep into the ground. Often they have no doors, ventilation or even seats. Sacred Relics of the Saints: Treasures of the Church
St. Francis of Assisi Parish presents a teaching and
exposition of Sacred Relics on Tuesday, June 28 at
6:30 p.m. in the Parish Hall with light snacks in the
Serra Room

Father Carlos Martins, a Vatican-appointed expert on relics, will be here with an extraordinary Vatican collection of over 150 relics, some as old as 2,000 vears. Among the treasures will be relics of St. Joseph, St. Maria Goretti, St. Therese of Lisieux (the "Little Flower"), St. Francis of Assisi, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Thomas Aquinas, and St. Faustina Kowalska. There will also be a portion of the Veil of Our Lady and one of the largest remaining pieces of the True Cross in the world. Those in attendance will be able to examine and venerate each relic. Throughout history, many healings have been worked in the presence of relics; and thousands have occurred through this ministry. Do not miss this opportunity. You are encouraged to bring your articles of devotion (such as rosaries, holy cards, etc.) and pictures of ill friends/family members, which you will be able to touch to the reliquaries as a means of intercession. This is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity. Please spread the word.



# **SPOTLIGHT ON SAFETY**

## Safe Lifting

To lift correctly:

- Your footing is a very important part of lifting. Your feet must be:
- --Close to the object.
- --Shoulder-width apart for good balance.



- --One foot slightly ahead of the other to help keep your center of gravity under control.
- Bend your knees and go down to a crouch--not to a full squat. Standing up from a full squat takes twice as much effort as standing from a crouch.
- Get a good, firm grip. Do not lift until your hold is strong and slip-proof.
- Lift by straightening your legs. Keep the load close to your body.
- If you have to change direction, do not twist your body; move your feet as you turn.
- When setting the load down:
- --Keep you back relatively straight.
- --Bend your knees just as you did when you lifted the object

**Be extra careful if you have not lifted recently:** Muscles can weaken and tighten while you are away on weekends or vacations so use extra caution when returning to work. Physical condition, muscle stretching, and toning are important steps before lifting begins each day.

# LITURGICAL CORNER

## Sunday Scriptures at Home

Many people find it helpful to pray over the Sunday Scripture reading at home before going to church. The practice put them in touch with the Church's prayer, helps them listen as the readings are proclaimed at Mass, prepares them to hear the homily, and engages them personally in the Word of God.

The Sunday readings are available in many publications and online at <u>www.usccb.org</u>. To prepare the readings at home, get a copy of them, or just get the citations and look them up in a Bible. Crate some time and space for this prayer. If you do it alone, remove yourself from other activities. Choose a place where you can center yourself. Open the Scriptures and read over them. You might keep a journal and jot down some questions such as these: "What is going on in this reading? Is something similar happening my life? What is God saying to me this week?"

If you pray with others, choose a time when everyone is together. You could pray in the living room at the end of the day or around the table before a meal. Someone reads the Scripture aloud. All think about it. Then each shares a few thoughts. Read the passage again. You may choose one or more readings at a time. The exercise can be repeated throughout the week. God's word is able to go as deep inside you as you give it time and room.

When you get to church, do not read along while the readings are proclaimed. Lift your head and open your ears and heart to the Word of God.

## Family Formation (Grades Preschool - Grade 5)

Family Formation is a family-based catechetical program that helps families grow in the transforming love of God by understanding and living the Catholic Faith. Families gather together in the parish once a month. Using the lessons provided, trained catechists teach the children in grade-level classrooms while parents attend an adult teaching on the same topic. Parents are then provided all the Home Lesson materials needed for the rest of the month to teach the Faith to their family.

### Preparation for First Reconciliation & First Holy Communion

The sacraments of Reconciliation and Holy Communion are typically celebrated the first time during the child's 2nd grade school year. Children prepare to receive the sacraments as registered students in the Family Formation program or through attendance at St. Francis of Assisi Catholic School.

### **Preparation for Confirmation**

The sacrament of Confirmation is one of the sacraments of initiation, along with Baptism and Eucharist. At St. Francis, preparation for Confirmation typically occurs during the student's 9<sup>th</sup> grade year and the sacrament is received during the fall of their 10<sup>th</sup> grade year. Students will attend seven small group sessions in preparation and meeting times will be set by each small group with most starting in the fall. Students will attend a retreat and receive the sacrament of Confirmation in the fall of 2023.

### Youth Ministry (Grades 6-12)

Youth Ministry is comprised of EDGE for 6-8th grade students and FISH for 9-12th grade students. Both programs are open to the youth of our parish who attend public, private, and home schools. In Youth Ministry, our youth can learn about their faith, find a Catholic community, and experience Jesus all while having fun and serving others.

### **Catechesis of the Good Shepherd\***

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) is a Montessori-based faith formation program for children ages 3-12. CGS takes place in specially prepared space called the Atrium. During Atrium time, the children are presented works of the atrium, after which they are invited to work with that presentation or any other presentation they have been presented. Prayer is essential to children, by working in concentration with these works of the atrium, children are able to enter into prayer more freely, unique to their individual needs. \*Space is limited.


