





STATIONS OF THE CROSS are prayed each Wednesday evenings during Lent at Holy Ghost at 6:45 p.m. and after the 8 a.m. Mass on Fridays at St. Stanislaus.

I THINK I DISCOVERED AN EXPLANATION WHY MANY PEOPLE HAVE STOPPED CONFESSING THEIR SINS IN THE SACRAMENT OF CHRIST'S MERCY They are afraid of God!

I recently read a fascinating book by Father Michael E. Gaitley, MIC, **The Second Greatest Story Ever Told** (Marian Press, 2016). He says that the answer may be found at the beginning of the Book of Genesis and in the Catechism of the Catholic Church.

The account of The Fall of Man (original sin) is found in Genesis 3:1-7. You might want to read that. The text indicates that God used to "walk" daily with Adam and Eve in the Garden. But on that fateful day, after eating the "forbidden fruit" we read, "They heard the sound of the Lord God walking in the garden ... and the man and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God among the trees of the garden. But the lord God called to the man, and said to him, 'Where are you?' And he (Adam) said, "I heard the sound of you in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked, and I hid myself" (Genesis 3:8).

Notice that Adam and Eve did not run to God; instead they ran away from God and tried to hide. Instead of running to Him and His merciful love they ran away.

They were afraid of God!

Father Gaitley maintains that the CATECHISM explains what happened. "Man, tempted by the devil, let his trust in his Creator die in his heart and, abusing his freedom, disobeyed God's command. This is what man's first sin consisted of. All Subsequent sin would be disobedience toward God and lack of trust in his goodness"

(n. 392). The CATECHISM goes on to explain that by sinning man preferred himself to God and by that very act scorned him. He chose himself over God. Man asserted he was equal to God and did not need to keep his command.

Genesis explains the consequences of this first act of disobedience, this first sin. Adam and Eve were created in a state of holiness. God planned to perfect that holiness somehow. But they allowed themselves to be seduced by the devil; they wanted **to be like God; to**

know what God knows. When they lost the grace of original holiness they became afraid of God and developed a distorted image. They saw God as jealous and vengeful.
