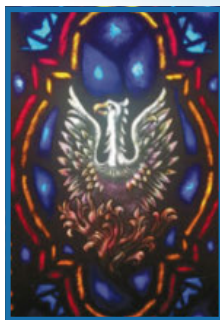

**It's Official!**

On Monday of Holy Week I had a follow-up appointment with the surgeon who did my spinal fusion last June. He assures me that I don't have any loose screws! But I still have to back off (pardon the pun) any activity that involves too much bending, twisting and lifting.

### **Catholic? catholic? Christian? What, if Anything is the Difference?**

One of the first grammar lessons we learn in school is the difference between a noun and a proper noun. A noun is the name of a person, place or thing: a boy, a girl, home, school, pencil, car. A proper noun is the name of a particular person, place or thing: Abraham Lincoln, Jesus, Omaha, Nazareth, Chevrolet, Dell Computer.

The word **"catholic"** (lower case c) is derived from the Latin word **"catholicus"** meaning **"universal"** or the Greek **"katholikos"** also meaning **"universal."** The spelling with lower case "c" is used in the Creed which identifies the 4 **"marks" of the Church**: one, holy, catholic and apostolic. In this sense it means that the Church that Christ founded (and He only founded ONE) was to spread throughout the entire world and encompass all mankind. In order to identify today the church founded by Jesus Christ it must possess all four "marks." That will only be found in the Roman Catholic Church.

The word **"Catholic"** (capital "C") identifies the Roman Church as distinct from other Christian denominations who do not recognize the primacy of the pope. Applied to the Church it was first used by St. Ignatius of Antioch (AD 35-107), bishop of Antioch in his Letter to the Smyrneans.

The earliest disciples were called followers of The Way (Acts 9:2; 19:9, 23; 22:4; 24:14, 22). This is important because Christianity was never meant to be just another religion, but a **Way**. (Remember Jesus said, **"I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me"** (John 14:6).

***"It was in Antioch that the disciples were first called Christians"*** Acts 11:26.

Most other Christians believe many of the things that we Catholics believe, **but they do not believe everything**. The Roman Catholic Church possesses and teaches in every generation ALL that Christ has revealed, whether it comes to us through SACRED SCRIPTURE, the written form of Divine Revelation or SACRED TRADITION, the unwritten form of Divine Revelation.

The simplest definition of Sacred Tradition is ***"everything that has been believed, practiced and taught by the Church from the time of the apostles to the present NOT contained in Sacred Scripture."***

There have been bodies of Christians who have broken away from unity with the pope and the Church in Rome through the centuries. What we call the Eastern Schism occurred in AD 1054 when churches which we now call "Orthodox" rejected the juridical authority of the Pope as the universal head of the Church. Whenever you see or hear about an Orthodox church you should know that they

are not fully united to the Roman Catholic Church but are actually closer in the unity of doctrine than Protestants. They never lost what we call **"apostolic succession"** which has to do with ordination of the clergy and the sacraments.

The demands are very clear. And the penalties will be severe. We're talking lawsuits, investigations and even imprisonment for those who do not comply. Quite simply, these proposed new rules would make Catholic healthcare illegal. And it would therefore force thousands of Catholic hospitals and charity organizations to give in, sell out, or shut down. That's 1 in 6 hospital beds in the United States gone.

Sure, there will be a public comment period, but it's unlikely that even a tidal wave of protest will change Secretary Becerra's devilish determination to deliver America up to the demands of the radical Left.

We certainly cannot look to President Biden to protect his fellow Catholics or any American of good conscience on this one.

**We need to reject such immorality at the ballot box, in the halls of Congress, and in the courts.**

Imagine what the Founding Fathers would say about a federal government that would shut down a religious hospital because it refused to castrate a young boy – or kill a baby partially born who can feel pain.

This is another example of why it is so important to become an informed voter and not just vote the Party. Abortion on demand has been a central plank in the Democrat platform for years.
