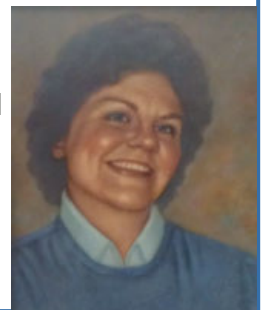
Wierzbicki Scholarship
