It is the model in faith, since we know that Jesus is the Son of God, born in the womb of the Virgin Mary, and Joseph is an adoptive father, who generously assumed to be a model of chastity and responsible fatherhood.

TAO Social Justice Activities and Invitation to Service . . .

Thank you! Gracias! Thank you! Merci beaucoup!

Our Advent collection of gift bags for Christmas led to overflowing baskets with gifts for men, women and children experiencing homelessness in shelters and transitional residences in the St. Cloud area.

Students and their families at All Saints Academy prepared more than 50 gift bags, and parishioners from St. Joseph in Waite Park, St. Michael's, St. Peter's and St. Paul's parishes each contributed for a total of over 150 gift bags. In addition, we received knit caps, slippers, toiletry items, skin care lotions, and many more miscellaneous additions for the gift bags.

A holiday celebration was planned at Dallas Place, a shelter on Hwy. 10 south, on Sunday, Dec. 12. The banquet hall of the former Michael's Restaurant was decorated in red and white, and musicians performed before, during and after the meal. Everyone wore masks except when eating.

The staff at Jules Bistro, led by baker Maddie and owner Donella, donated and plated a turkey dinner with fruit cups, turkey, dressing, potatoes and gravy, corn and beans, along with coffee and water. Dessert was apple strudel topped with vanilla bean ice cream.

Members of our TAO Social Justice committee helped serve the meal to about 70 guests. After dinner, the committee members presented gift bags and an insulated mug (donated by Scheels) to each guest.

The St. Paul's Christian Women provided hundreds of socks from their November Sock Drive, and the guests were invited to pick the socks they wanted from a wide variety of styles and colors.

One of our committee members had this reaction to the day's events: "I really enjoyed serving the friends of Lincoln Center. You could see and feel the true love Harry (Fleegel) has for each one of them and you could feel their caring spirit for each other. I loved interacting with them and the music was wonderful. At the end it was joyful the way Harry got into dancing to the jazz music."

Due to the generosity of our TAO community, the Social Justice committee was able to expand the gift-giving from Dallas Place and Lincoln Center to other organizations including Terebinth Refuge, Anna Marie's Alliance, the Sexual Assault Center, the Dream Center, and Place of Hope.

There is no route mileage reimbursement available for drivers; however, routes have been adjusted so deliveries take approximately one hour. Drivers needed Monday between 10:30am-12:30pm. Can't make a weekly commitment? Be a substitute driver!

Catholic Charities Emergency Services Food Shelf provides access to healthy food for people faced with missing meals. Volunteers are needed URGENTLY to help with distribution. 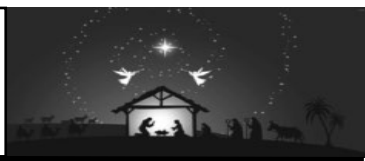
