

A Note From Fr. OSWALDO

Ordinary Time.

In this week, ordinary time begins, after the feast of the Lord's baptism. The word ordinary can be interpreted as something without formality, that is, as the most normal thing, sometimes without rule or without restrictions.

For that reason, we think we can relax and take vacations, especially from practicing our faith. In the Gospel of John, Jesus is shown going to a wedding, the most normal and ordinary of a person, going to parties, meetings, games, to work or school.

The trap of evil is to make us believe that during this time anything is valid, but if we see what Jesus did, it is the opposite. It is a time, to be more alert, because we can (suddenly run out of wine), that is, grace, faith and the joy that we brought from Christmas time.

The figure of Mary is important, especially when we feel that we are failing in faith. She intercedes for us, and Jesus manifests himself by renewing our hope and faith. It is in the ordinary time of everyday living, that the evil one will try to catch us. Let's not lower our guard. Let's be alert, because like a roaring lion, he looks for someone to devour. Let us stand firm in the faith. Let us not forget to turn to Mary when we feel weak and afflicted.

A los novios se le acabo el vino, la figura de María es importante, especialmente, cuando sentimos que fallamos en la fe. Ella intercede por nosotros y Jesús se manifiesta renovando nuestra esperanza y la fe. Es tiempo de lo cotidiano, por eso el maligno tratará de pescarnos, no bajemos la guardia, estemos alerta, porque como león rugiente, busca a quien devorar. Estemos firmes en la fe. No olvidemos recurrir a María, cuando nos sintamos débiles y afligidos.



Janet encourages us to participate in this free keynote presentation and conversation on Jan. 17, and she offers information and registration assistance for anyone who chooses to take this opportunity.


