

### Where Families Belong!

First Sacrament students' focus will be on their First Eucharist, with a First Eucharist Retreat on January 14th from 9:00- 11:00 am at St. Peters. Please continue to pray for these students and their families as they prepare for this beautiful Sacrament of God's love and mercy.

### Together As One Pastoral Care Ministry news.....

Dear friends;

I hope you have all had a good Advent experience! It seems impossible to believe that Christmas is right around the corner. We are all busy during this time but we also need to focus on what the true meaning of Christmas is. During this celebratory time, we need to be mindful that with the gatherings, there are family units that are broken and hurt and need to be fixed. Sometimes these hurts prevent us from getting together with friends and family; forgiveness is the gift that is much needed and very difficult to give and even harder to receive. We can take steps to gain the freedom that forgiveness brings:

FORGIVE YOURSELF first of all. We can choose to liberate ourselves and become better instead of nursing bitterness and hatred.

FORGIVE OTHERS: families- don't dwell on each other's faults. The only person I can change is ME. Married Couples - There is a quote from writer Lawrence Crabb, Jr who says, "any marriage is the union of two sinners. A happy marriage is the union of two forgivers".

FORGIVE GOD: If we believe that it is God's fault when bad things happen to good people we need to change the mindset that this is not God's will but rather a result of fallen humanity to get us past blaming God.

*PRAY:* We have to realize that forgiveness is a process and we need God's help to pray! Forgiveness is good for all of us – it is good physically and Spiritually. God will help us but we must ask him.

If you are thinking of gifts for someone keep in mind the very necessary gifts listed below. These are not just to be given during the holidays but all year long. You receive more than you give!

Provide comfort to someone. Many among us are facing illness – and unfortunately, facing it alone. These people can use a phone call, a note or encouragement and a shoulder to lean on.

Go to see 1 person a month at any one of the local nursing homes or apartments. This doesn't entail spending an entire afternoon with him or her - a few minutes means so much to each one you visit.

If you see someone struggling to carry groceries, help them to their car

Surprise a neighbor with cookies

LISTEN to someone who needs to be heard

Volunteer with Catholic Charities - at the food shelf or with the needy

Babysit for that young couple so they can go out for dinner or a movie
