# FROM FATHER MARQUARD

## MARATHON!

I had big plans for this year's Good Shepherd Marathon. In order to help raise money for our school, I was going to complete the Twin Cities Marathon — my first such attempt in more than a decade. (I completed a marathon in 2007, told myself I was going to take a few weeks off, and then didn't run again until this year.) Anyway, training was going quite well until the first week of August. And then it wasn't going well at all. Due to some serious pain in my right hip, I had to stop running. I gave it four weeks of rest and then tried again on Labor Day. No good. I couldn't even go 10 strides. After consultation with an orthopedic surgeon, I resigned to putting the Twin Cities on hold. Maybe next year.

That said, the Good Shepherd Marathon is still happening. And, it's happening soon. And so, like in years past, I'll be riding for dollars. Your dollars! Last year, thanks to your generosity in pledging \$6,620, I rode 662 miles (and then some). This year, I'm hoping that we can make it past 750 miles. I will ride one mile for every \$10 pledged to the Good Shepherd Marathon. That would be \$7,500 for our school.

If you would like to support our school and make me put on some miles, please stop by the table in the gathering space. Your donations to the cause will help us provide our students with quality religion curricula and retreat opportunities, STEM programming, music, art, and technology.
