### GOOD SHEPHERD AND PHASE II

We have entered into Phase II of the archdiocesan directives for the celebration of public Mass during the pandemic. We are able to host Masses for up to 96 people. The obligation to attend Sunday Mass and Holy Days of Obligation continues to be suspended as long as the pandemic continues. This means that you are not presently obligated to attend Mass. You should only come to Mass if you feel comfortable doing so.

All COVID-19 positive persons, those who are symptomatic, and those living with them, must stay home.

Persons over age 65 and those with preexisting health conditions should continue to stay home during Phase II and avoid public gatherings, including in church.

Face masks are strongly urged for all those who come for Mass, Confession, and Adoration.

THE BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

The Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, also known as the Feast of Corpus Christi, celebrates the Real Presence of the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. The solemnity dates back to the year 1264, when Pope Urban IV established the feast and asked a theologian named Thomas Aquinas to compose liturgical texts for the Mass and the Liturgy of the Hours.

Many of the texts composed by Saint Thomas Aquinas remain with us today. His hymn for the office of readings, *Sacris Solemnis* includes the meditation *Panis Angelicus*; the hymn for morning prayer, *Verbum Supernum Prodiens*, gives us the *O Salutaris Hostia* used at exposition of the Blessed Sacrament; the hymn for evening prayer, *Pange Lingua Gloriosi*, gives us the *Tantum Ergo* verses used at benediction; and his hymn of thanksgiving, *Adoro Te Devote*, is the basis for *Hidden Here Before Me*, which we often sing here.

These texts are rich in theology and devout love for the Lord and the gift of the Eucharist — truly sacred texts that lift the heart to contemplate divine mysteries. One of them, which we will hear recited on this feast, is the sequence for the Mass, *Lauda Sion Salvatorem* (Sion, Lift Up thy Voice and Sing). This is one of the three remaining sequences we encounter each year, along with the *Victimae Paschali Laudes* for Easter and the *Veni Sancte Spiritus* for Pentecost. A sequence is a chanted hymn that is recited before the proclamation of the Gospel.

Here is the translation of today's sequence, as found in the Lectionary for Mass. I encourage you to spend some time with it, to pray with it, and to lift up your heart in gratitude for the great gift we have received in the Eucharist.

Laud, O Zion, your salvation,  
Laud with hymns of exultation,  
Christ, your king and shepherd true:

Bring him all the praise you know,  
He is more than you bestow.  
Never can you reach his due.

Special theme for glad thanksgiving  
Is the quick'ning and the living  
Bread today before you set:

From his hands of old partaken,  
As we know, by faith unshaken,  
Where the Twelve at supper met.

Full and clear ring out your chanting,  
Joy nor sweetest grace be wanting,  
From your heart let praises burst:

For today the feast is holden,  
When the institution olden  
Of that supper was rehearsed.

Here the new law's new oblation,  
By the new king's revelation,  
Ends the form of ancient rite:

Now the new the old effaces,  
Truth away the shadow chases,  
Light dispels the gloom of night.

What he did at supper seated,  
Christ ordained to be repeated,  
His memorial ne'er to cease:

And his rule for guidance taking,  
Bread and wine we hallow, making  
Thus our sacrifice of peace.

This the truth each Christian learns,  
Bread into his flesh he turns,  
To his precious blood the wine:

Sight has fail'd, nor thought conceives,  
But a dauntless faith believes,  
Resting on a pow'r divine.

Here beneath these signs are hidden  
Priceless things to sense forbidden;  
Signs, not things are all we see:

Blood is poured and flesh is broken,  
Yet in either wondrous token  
Christ entire we know to be.

Whoso of this food partakes,  
Does not rend the Lord nor breaks;  
Christ is whole to all that taste:

Thousands are, as one, receivers,  
One, as thousands of believers,  
Eats of him who cannot waste.

Bad and good the feast are sharing,  
Of what divers dooms preparing,  
Endless death, or endless life.

Life to these, to those damnation,  
See how like participation  
Is with unlike issues rife.

When the sacrament is broken,  
Doubt not, but believe 'tis spoken,  
That each sever'd outward token  
doth the very whole contain.

Nought the precious gift divides,  
Breaking but the sign betides  
Jesus still the same abides,  
still unbroken does remain.

Lo! the angel's food is given  
To the pilgrim who has striven;  
see the children's bread from heaven,  
which on dogs may not be spent.

Truth the ancient types fulfilling,  
Isaac bound, a victim willing,  
Paschal lamb, its lifeblood spilling,  
manna to the fathers sent.

Very bread, good shepherd, tend us,  
Jesu, of your love befriend us,  
You refresh us, you defend us,  
Your eternal goodness send us  
In the land of life to see.

You who all things can and know,  
Who on earth such food bestow,  
Grant us with your saints, though lowest,  
Where the heav'nly feast you show,  
Fellow heirs and guests to be. Amen. Alleluia.
